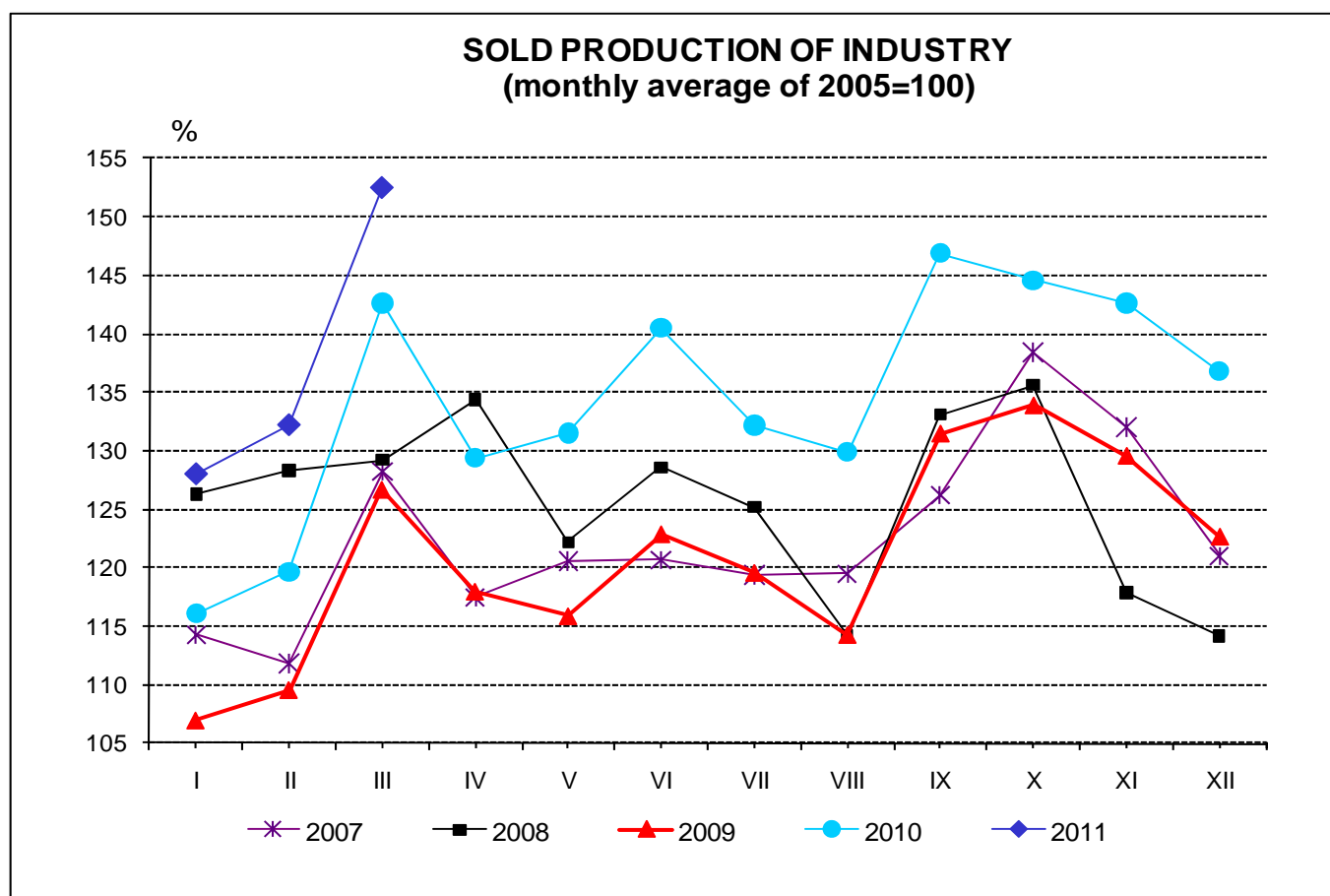

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in March 2011 was by 7.0% higher than in the previous year and by 15.3% higher than in February 2011. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 5.3% than in the corresponding month of the previous year, but lower by 0.4% than in February 2011.

As compared to March 2010, an increase in sold production was reported in 22 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 29.5%, manufacture of furniture – by 28.0%, manufacture of metal products – by 20.6%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 19.3%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 18.5% and manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 17.2%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to March 2010, was recorded in 12 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 10.9%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 6.3%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 4.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 3.8% and in manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 3.7%.

In the period January-March 2011 sold production of industry was by 9.2% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to the preliminary data, **the construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in March 2011 higher by 24.2% than in the previous year and by 42.4% in comparison to February of this year. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, the construction and assembly production reached the level higher by 15.2% than in the corresponding month in the previous year and by 3.1% in comparison to February 2011.

Both in relation to March of the previous year and February of this year, an increase of level of realized works was recorded in all construction divisions. In comparison to March 2010 in entities mainly involved in specialized construction works the production grew by 35.6%, in enterprises of which mainly kind of activity are works connected with civil engineering – by 33.5% and in entities mainly realizing construction works connected with construction of buildings – by 13.0%.

In comparison with February 2011 an increase of production in enterprises the basic activity of which are works connected with civil engineering amounted to 53.0%, in carrying out specialized construction activities 41.6% and in realizing construction works connected with construction of buildings 36.9%.

The level of the construction and assembly production realized in the period January-March of 2011 was by 18.8% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of the construction and assembly production, in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:
