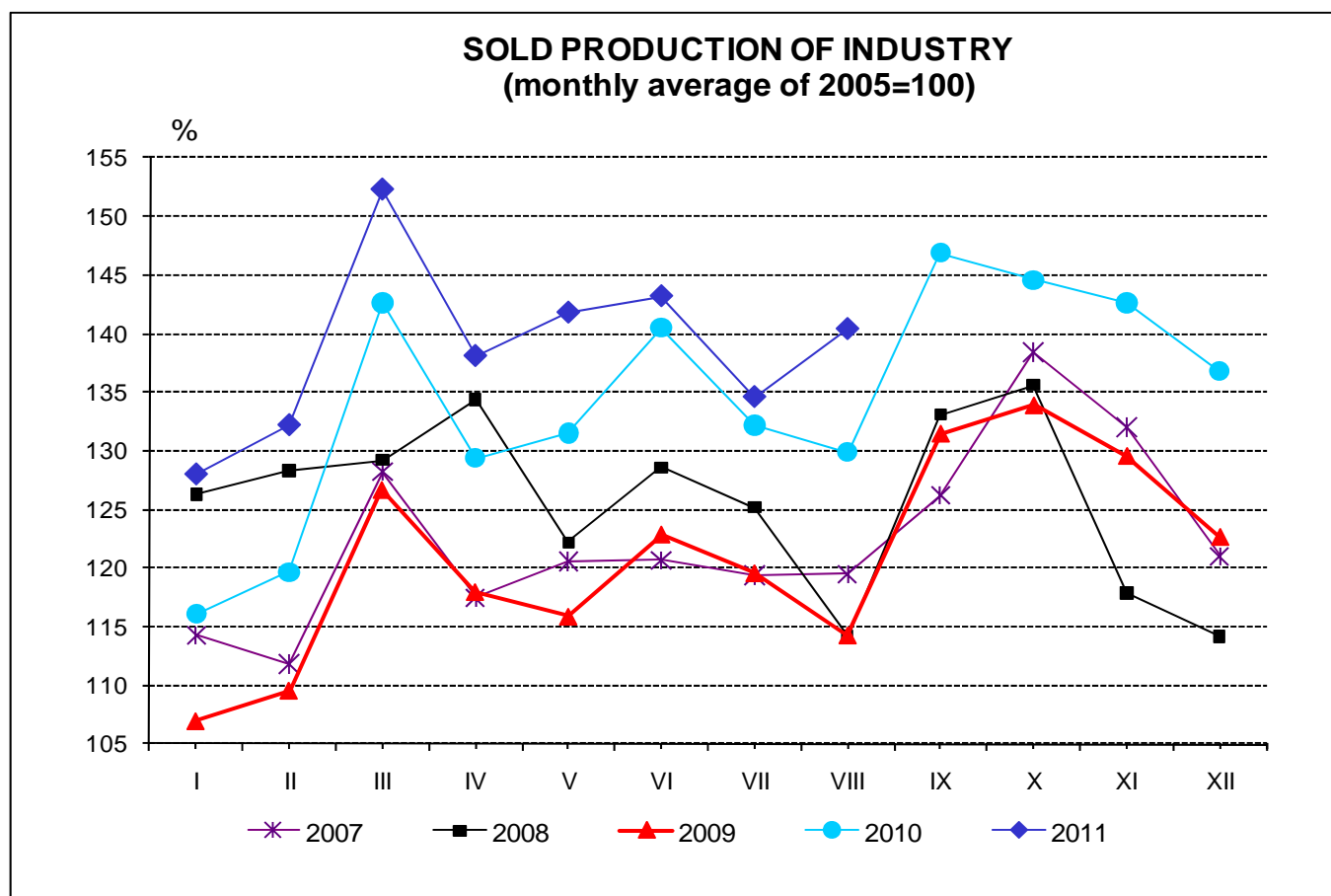

According to the preliminary data **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in August 2011 was by 8.1% higher than in the previous year and by 4.3% higher than in July 2011. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 5.4% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 2.2% than in July 2011.

As compared to August 2010, an increase in sold production was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 24.0%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 23.2%, manufacture of metal products – by 17.9%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 17.6%, manufacture of furniture – by 16.2% and manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 14.3%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to August 2010, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.5%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 8.1% and in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 7.1%.

In the period January-August 2011 sold production of industry was by 6.9% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons in August of 2011 was by 10.8% higher than in the previous year and by 1.5% than in July of 2011. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 13.7% higher than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 0.4% lower in comparison to July of 2011.

In comparison to August of the previous year, an increase in the amount of work completed was recorded in all divisions of construction, i.e. in enterprises whose basic type of activity is specialized construction activities by 22.8%, in units primarily carrying out civil engineering by 15.2% and in entities dealing mainly with construction of buildings by 1.5%.

In comparison to July of 2011, an increase in production occurred in enterprises whose basic type of activity is specialized construction activities by 5.7% and in entities carrying out construction of buildings by 4.3%. A decrease was recorded in units dealing mainly with civil engineering by 3.5%.

In the period January-August 2011 the construction and assembly production was by 18.5% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
