

According to the preliminary data **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in September of 2012 was by 5.2% lower than in the previous year (when an increase by 7.4% was recorded), but by 6.1% higher than in August of 2012. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level lower by 1.6% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and lower by 1.4% than in August of 2012.

As compared to September of 2011, a drop in sold production was reported in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of furniture – by 18.1%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 15.5%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 13.8%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 12.7%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 6.1% and manufacture of basic metals – by 5.8%. An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to September of 2011, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 11.2%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 2.0% and manufacture of food products – by 0.6%.

In the period January-September of 2012 sold production of industry was by 2.5% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons, was in September of 2012 by 17.8% lower than a year before (in which an increase by 18.1% was recorded) and by 2.2% higher in comparison to August of 2012. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level 9.5% lower than in the corresponding month of the previous year and 2.0% lower in comparison to August of 2012.

In relation to September of 2011 a decrease in the level of carried out work was recorded in all divisions of construction, i.e. in entities whose basic type of activity is the construction of buildings – by 22.9%., in entities dealing mainly with civil engineering – by 14.9% and in entities performing specialised construction activities – by 13.9%.

In comparison to August of this year, an increase in production was recorded in all divisions of construction, while in enterprises realizing mainly construction work connected with construction of building – by 4.5%, in entities carrying out specialised construction activities – by 1.9% and in entities connected with civil engineering – by 0.4%

In the period January-September of 2012, construction and assembly production was 1.4% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
