

According to the preliminary data **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in June of 2012 was by 1.2% higher than in the previous year, but lower by 2.0% than in May of 2012. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 2.6% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and lower by 2.0% than in May of 2012.

As compared to June of 2011, an increase in sold production was reported in 18 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 11.1%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 9.3%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 8.2%, manufacture of food products – by 7.0%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 5.7%, and manufacture of metal products – by 4.8%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to June of 2011, was recorded in 16 divisions, among others, in manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 12.5%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 9.2%, in manufacture of furniture – by 8.8%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 7.6% and manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 7.2%.

In the period January-June of 2012 sold production of industry was by 3.8% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in June of 2012 by 5.1% lower than a year before and by 5.1% higher in comparison to May this year. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 1.7% higher than in corresponding month of the previous year and by 2.4% lower than in May of 2012.

In relation to June of 2011 the increase in production was noted in enterprises dealing mainly with specialized construction activities – by 2.1% and building construction – by 0.5 %, while the drop in units specializing in civil engineering amounted by 14.0%.

In comparison to May of 2012 an increase in production occurred in all sections of construction, i.e. in enterprises carrying out specialized construction activities – by 15.8 %, work connected with civil engineering – by 3.8%, and in entities realizing mainly building construction – by 0.5%.

In the period January-June of 2012 the construction-assembly was by 8.0% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
