

Price indices of sold production of industry and construction and assembly production in July 2018

According to preliminary data in July 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 0.1% higher in comparison to June 2018, it is estimated that the prices of construction and assembly production in July 2018 increased by 0.3% in comparison to the previous month.

According to preliminary data in July 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 3.4% in comparison to July 2017. The prices increase was also recorded in construction and assembly production – by 3.1%. In the period January-July 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 1.6% in comparison to the corresponding period 2017 (when the growth was recorded – by 3.4%), the prices of construction and assembly production increased by 2.2% (the growth in 2017 – by 0.3%).

The prices in industry in July 2018 in annual terms were higher by 3.4%, in construction – by 3.1%

In July 2018 in comparison to the previous month this year prices increase was recorded in most section of industry. The drop of prices was recorded in section mining and quarrying. In comparison to corresponding month of the previous year prices in all section of industry increased

The prices of sold production of industry

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in July 2018 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing by 0.2%, in which in manufacturing of textiles, of tobacco products (by 0.8% each), of leather and related products (by 0.7%), of chemicals and chemical products, of wearing apparel (by 0.6% each), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.5%), of coke and refined petroleum products, of paper and paper products (by 0.4% each), of beverages, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.3% each), of metal products, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.2% each), of food products, of rubber and plastic products, of electrical equipment as well as of other transport equipment (by 0.1% each). The prices of printing and reproduction of recorded media reached the level similar to the one recorded in June 2018. The drop of prices were recorded among other things in manufacture of furniture, of machinery and equipment (of 0.1% each), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.2%), of pharmaceutical products (of 0.3%), of basic metals (of 0.4%). The growth of prices was recorded in sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply and water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 0.1% each. The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying of 2.8%, of which in mining of metal ores (of 7.1%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (of 1.2%).

In July 2018 in comparison to the previous month the biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing of textiles as well as of tobacco products by 0.8% each (in comparison to December 2017 the growth was respectively 2.0% and 1.4% and in comparison to July of the previous year – 1.6% and 1.4%)

In July 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 3.4% higher than a year earlier. The biggest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 5.2%. The prices increased in manufacturing - by 3.6%, in which the most in manufacturing of coke and refined petroleum products (by 33.8%). The growth of prices was also recorded in manufacture of basic metals (by 8.7%), of paper and paper products (by 6.0%), of leather and related products (by 4.4%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 4.2%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 3.7%), of wearing apparel (by 3.6%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 2.7%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 2.4%), of metal products (by 1.7%), of textiles (by 1.6%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of rubber and plastic products (by 1.5% each), of tobacco products (by 1.4%), of furniture (by 1.2%), of electrical equipment (by 0.8%), of beverages (by 0.6%), of machinery and equipment (by 0.1%). The drop of prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of other transport equipment (of 0.2%), of food products (by 0.3%), of pharmaceutical products (of 0.9%) as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (of 1.9%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities were higher by 1.6% and in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 0.1%.

In July 2018 in comparison to July of the previous year biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 33.8% (in comparison to December 2017 the growth was 16.8%, and in comparison to the previous month – 0.4%)


The prices of construction and assembly production

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in July 2018 were by 0.3% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in civil engineering (by 0.4%), in construction of buildings as well as in specialised construction activities (by 0.3% each).

In comparison to July of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production were higher by 3.1%. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings (by 3.3%), in civil engineering (by 3.2%) as well as in specialised construction activities (by 2.6%).

Prices in construction in July 2018 in annual terms increased in all divisions of construction

Chart 2. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry in 2017-2018 (XII previous year = 100)




Chart 3. Dynamics of prices of assembly and construction production in 2017-2018 (XII previous year = 100)





Chart 4. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry sections in 2018 (XII previous year = 100)
