

In January of 2015, **sold production of industry** was by 1.7% higher than in January of 2014 which saw a 4.2% increase, whereas **construction-assembly production** was by 1.3% higher than in the corresponding period of 2014 which saw a 3.9% decrease.

Index numbers of industrial and construction-assembly production in real time (constant prices) were:



According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons), in January of 2015, was by 1.7% higher than in the previous year and by 3.1% lower than in December of 2014. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 4.0% than in the corresponding month of 2014 and by 0.4% higher than in December of 2014.

As compared to January of 2014, an increase in sold production was reported in 22 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 12.5%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.2%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 12.1%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 11.4%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 11.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 4.6%, manufacture of basic metals – by 4.2%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to January of 2014, was recorded in 11 divisions, among others, in manufacture of beverages – by 12.0%, mining of coal and lignite – by 8.5%, manufacture of coke, refined petroleum products – by 7.1%, electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 5.8%.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2010 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, construction and assembly production (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing 9 January of 2015 1.3% more than persons, was in by higher than a year before and by 65.2% lower in comparison to December of 2014. After eliminating the seasonal assembly production the construction and reached level higher in comparison to January of 2014 and by 0.7% lower in comparison to December of 2014.

In relation to January of 2014, an increase in production was recorded in entities whose basic type of activity is the construction of buildings by 2.6% and in entities dealing mainly with specialised construction activities by 7.5%. There was a decrease in enterprises specializing in civil engineering by 6.3%.

Indices of the construction and assembly production, in comparison with an average monthly level in 2010, are presented in the graph below:
