According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in October of 2010 were at a level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. Prices were higher in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 1.1%). However the drop prices was recorded mining and quarrying as well as in manufacturing (of 0.1% each). In manufacturing the most drop was recorded in the prices of manufacturing of computer, electronic and optical products (of 1.5%). The drop prices was also recorded among other things in manufacture of other transport equipment (of 1.2%), of electrical equipment, of wearing apparel (of 0.8% each), of coke and refined petroleum products (of 0.7%), of beverages (of 0.5%), of food products, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.3% each), of other non-metallic mineral products, of machinery and equipment (of 0.2% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of rubber and plastic products, of furniture as well as of pharmaceutical products (of 0.1 each%). However, the growth was recorded in the prices in manufacture of textiles (by 0.2%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.3%), of metal products (by 0.4%), of leather and related products (by 0.5%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.6%), of paper and paper products (by 1.4%), basic metals (by 1.9%) as well as of tobacco products (by 4.3%). The drop prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 0.3%).

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 4.5%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 15.0%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 23.2%) and in mining of coal and lignite (of 13.6%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply raised by 5.1% each. The growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 3.7%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 27.9%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 19.6%), of paper and paper products (by 11.4%), of tobacco products (by 7.9%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 6.0%), other transport equipment (by 3.5%), of food products as well as of pharmaceutical products (by 3.3% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 3.2%), of rubber and plastic products (by 2.6%). However the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacture of beverages (by 0.9%), of furniture (by 1.5%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.7%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 1.9%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 3.5%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 3.6%), of electrical equipment (by 4.1%) as well as of wearing apparel (by 5.5%).

In October of 2010 the prices of sold production of industry were by 4.0% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 17.4%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 5.5%), electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 5.1%) as well as in manufacturing (of 2.7%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in October of 2010 were at a level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction (by 0,1% each). However, the prices in construction of buildings were of 0.1% lower than in the previous month.

In October of 2010 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 0.1% lower than in December of previous year and by 0.1% higher than in October of the previous year.

Fig. 1. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry in 2009-2010

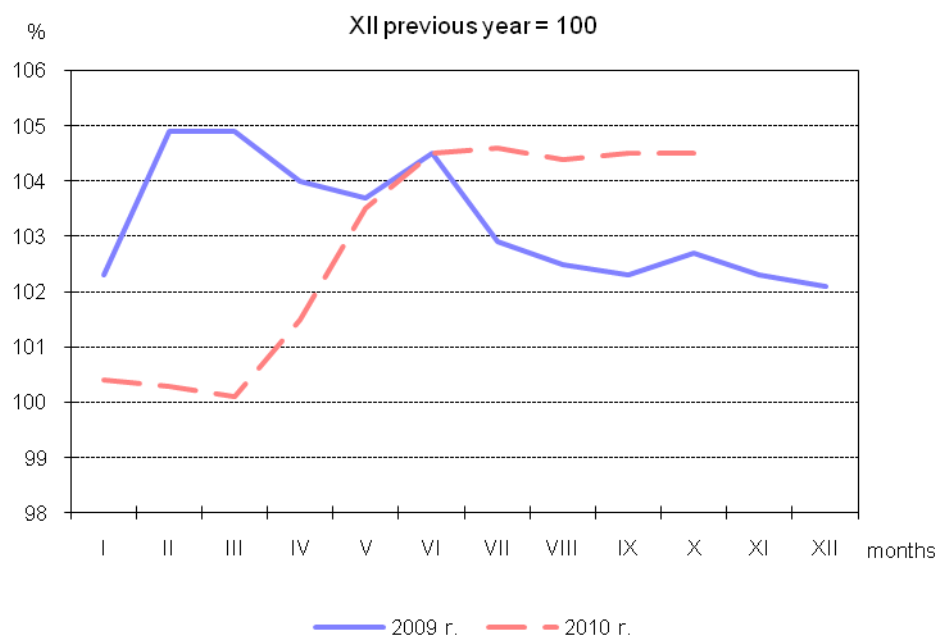


Fig. 2. Dynamics of prices of construction and assembly production in 2009-2010

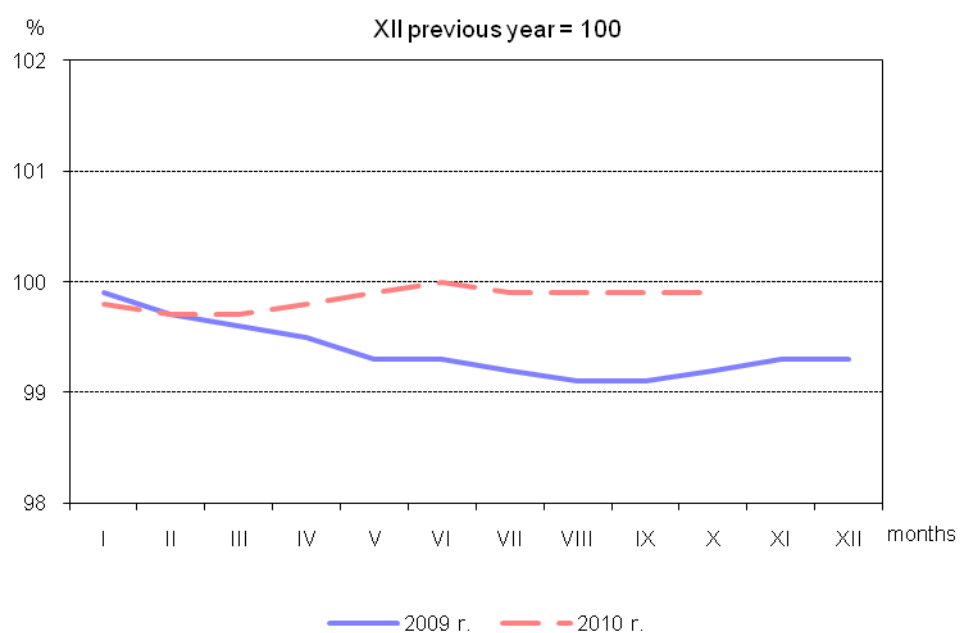

Dynamics of prices in 2010 XII previous year = 100

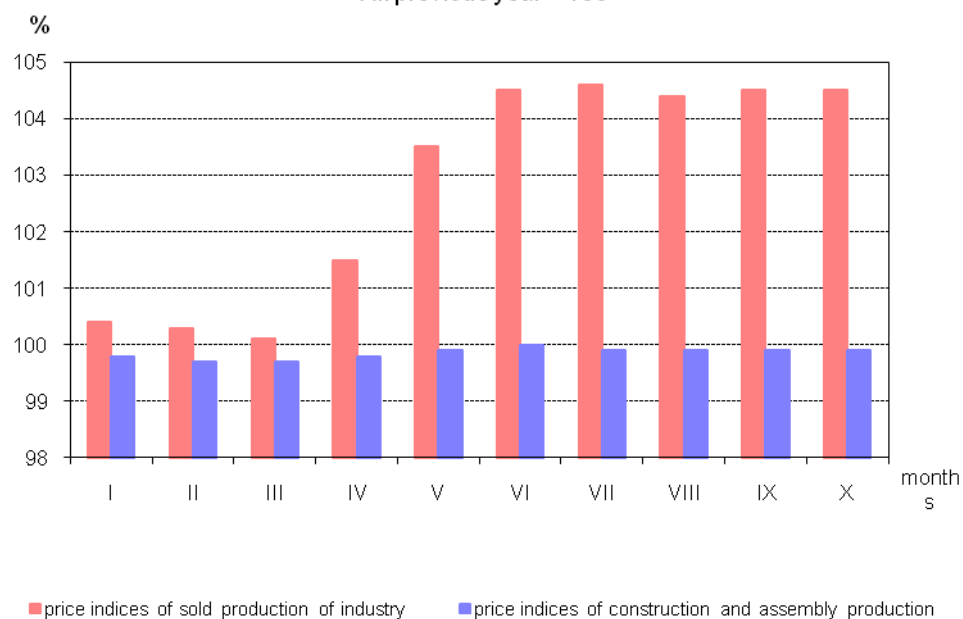
