According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in May of 2010 were by 1.6% higher than in the previous month. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (of 1.8%), of which in manufacture of basic metals (of 6.2%). Prices were raised also in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 3.6%), motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of paper and paper products (by 2.1% each), of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.0%), of electrical equipment (by 1.8%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.7%), of metal products (by 1.6%), of other transport equipment, of wearing apparel (by 1.5% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 1.2%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 1.1%), of food products (by 1.0%), of machinery and equipment, of textiles (by 0.9% each), of other non-metallic mineral products, of furniture (by 0.7% each), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.6%), of leather and related products (by 0.3%) as well as of beverages (by 0.1%). However, the drop was recorded in the prices of manufacturing of tobacco products (by 0.1%) as well as printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.4%). Prices in mining and quarrying raised by 0.8%, of which in mining of coal and lignite (by 1.2%) and in mining of metal ores (by 0.3%). The growth prices was also recorded in section: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 0.5%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 0.3%).

In May of 2010 the prices of sold production of industry were by 1.5% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 17.2%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 7.0%), electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (of 1.4%) as well as in manufacturing (of 0.2%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in May of 2010 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded in construction of buildings, civil engineering as well as specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each).

In comparison to May of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production were at a level similar to the one recorded in the previous year.

XII previous year = 100

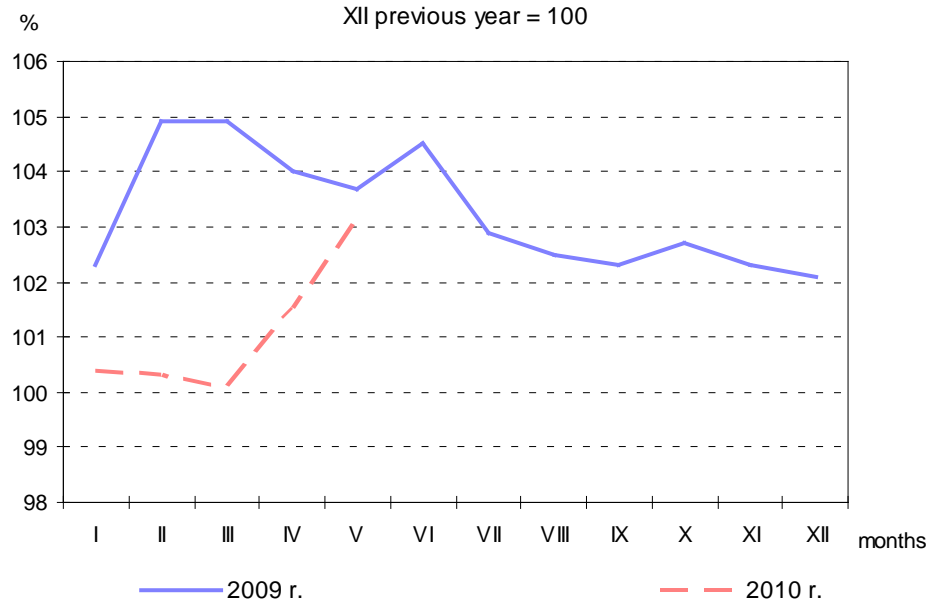

XII previous year = 100

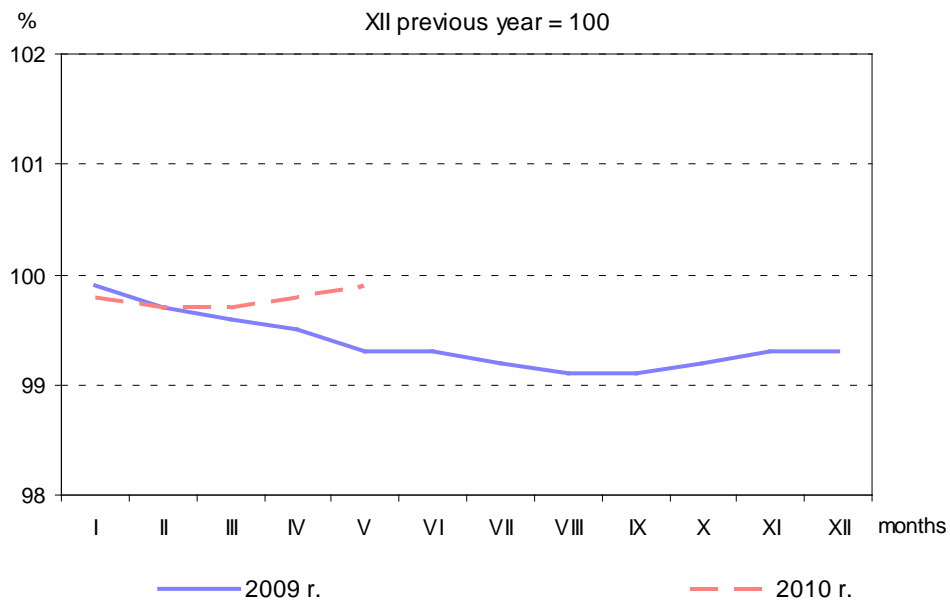
