According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in September of 2011 were by 0.7% higher than in the previous month. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 1.7%), of which in mining of metal ores (by 4.9%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (by 0.2%). The growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 0.7%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.6%). The growth of prices was recorded also in among other things in manufacturing of basic metals, of computer, electronic and optical products, of leather and related products (by 1.1% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of wearing apparel (by 0.9% each), of paper and paper products, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0,8% each), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.6%), of other non-metallic mineral products, of machinery and equipment, of other transport equipment (by 0.5% each), of food products, of electrical equipment, of textiles (by 0.4% each), of metal products, of furniture, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.2% each). However, the drop was recorded in the prices in manufacturing of chemicals and chemical products, (of 0.3%), of beverages as well as of pharmaceutical products (of 0.4% each). The growth was recorded in the prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.1%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 7.5%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 8.4%), of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 28.9%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 11.9%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 10.8%), of food products (by 9.6%), of rubber and plastic products (by 9.0%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 8.1%), of paper and paper products (by 7.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 5.9%), of pharmaceutical products (by 5.7%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 5.4%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of other transport equipment (by 5.0% each), of metal products (by 4.9%), of textiles (by 4.5%), of electrical equipment (by 3.1%), of furniture (by 1.8%) as well as of beverages (by 0.9%). However the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.2%) as well as in printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.0%). The growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 4.3%, in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 3.9%, as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 2.8%.

In September of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 8.9% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 10.3%). The prices were also increased in section: manufacturing (by 9.6%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.6%) as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 2.9%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in September of 2011 reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. Not big the growth prices, by 0,1%, was recorded and in specialised construction activities.

In September 2011 the prices of construction and assembly production were by 1.8% higher than in December of previous year and by 1.7% higher than in September of the previous year.

in 2010-2011

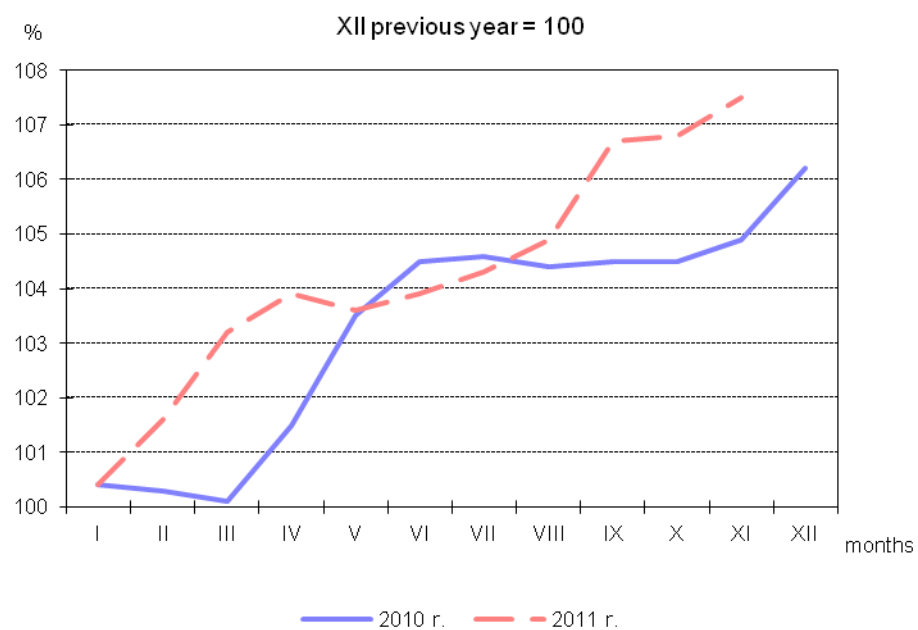

in 2010-2011

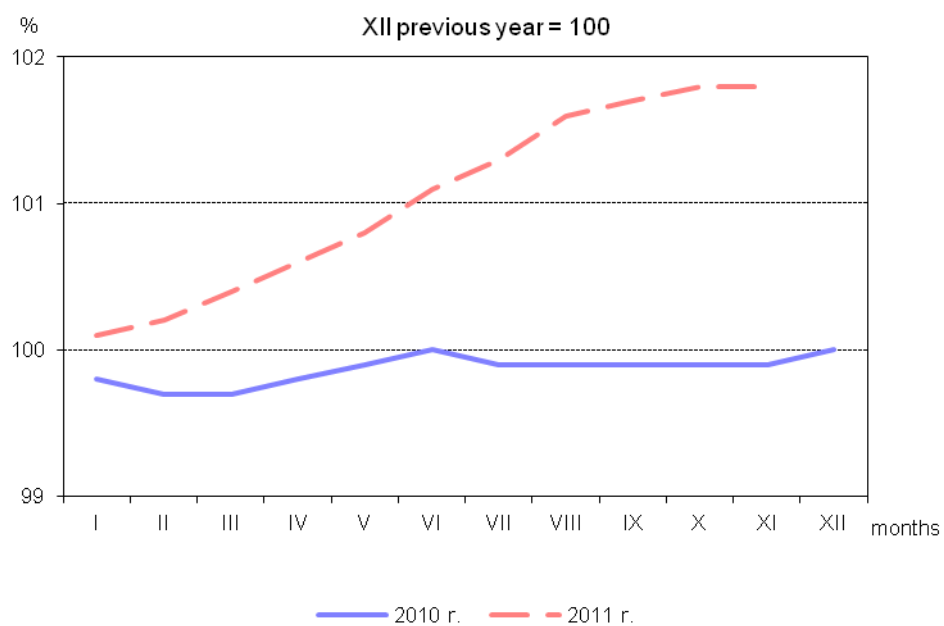

Dynamics of prices in 2011 XII previous year = 100

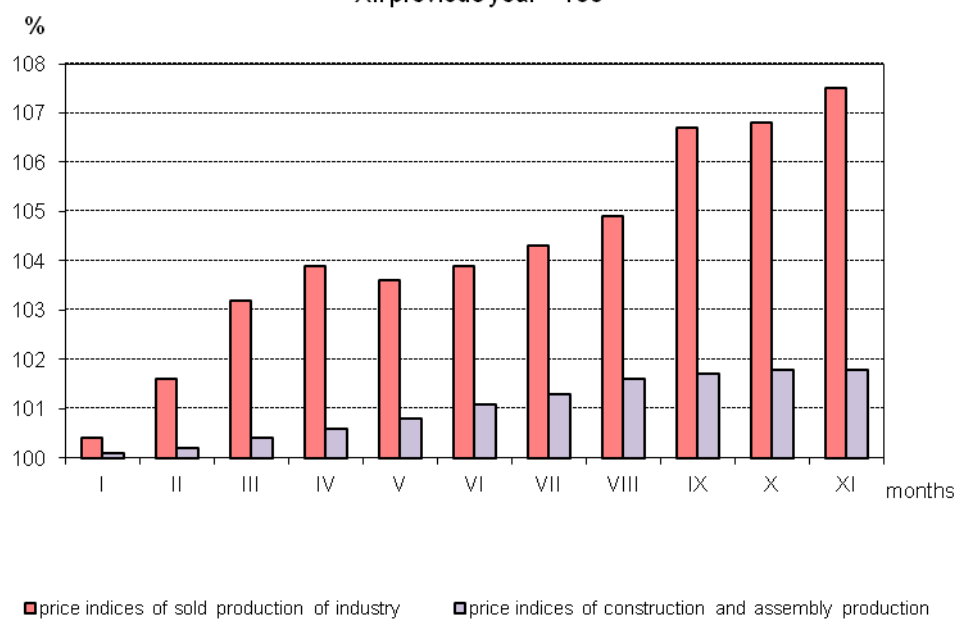
