According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in September of 2011 were by 1.4% higher than in the previous month. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 1.6%), of which the biggest price growth was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 4.7%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things in manufacturing of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 2.6%), of basic metals (by 2.0%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.9%), of metal products, chemicals and chemical products (by 1.5% each), of other transport equipment (by 1.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.2%), of paper and paper products, of leather and related products (by 1.0% each), of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of textiles (by 0.8% each), of food products, of manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products, of electrical equipment (by 0.7% each), of wearing apparel (by 0.6%), of furniture (by 0.5%), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.4%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.2%). However, the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacturing of beverages (of 0.1%), as well as of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.3%). The prices in mining and quarrying was higher (by 0.8%), of which in mining of metal ores (by 2.4%), as well as in mining of coal and lignite (by 0.2%). The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply raised by 0.1%. However the drop was recorded in the prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (of 0.1%).

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 6.4%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 6.9%), of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 22.9%). Prices were raised also among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 12.8%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 10.4%), of food products (by 8.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 7.3%), of paper and paper products (by 6.6%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 6.3%), of pharmaceutical products (by 4.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 4.7%), of metal products, of other non-metallic mineral products (by 4.6% each), of textiles (by 3.3%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 3.1%), of other transport equipment (by 3.0%), of beverages (by 2.2%) as well as of electrical equipment (by 2.1%). However the drop was recorded in the prices among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (of 2.2%) as well as in printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 3.1%).

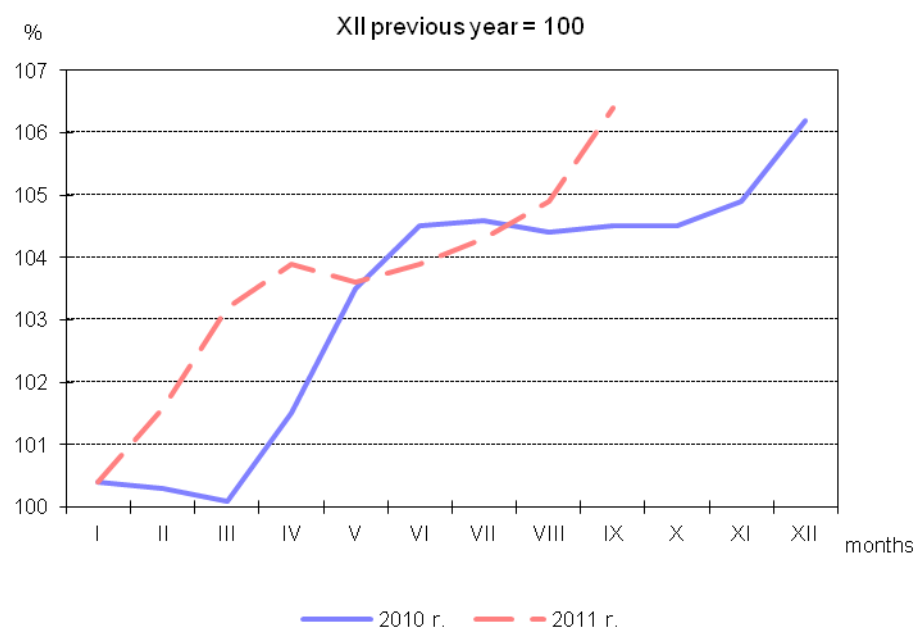
The growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 6.4%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 4.2% as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 2.7%.

In September of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 8.1% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 14.3%). The prices were also increased in section: manufacturing (by 8.3%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.8%) as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 4.0%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in September of 2011 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded, in specialised construction activities (by 0.2%), in construction of buildings as well as in civil engineering (by 0.1% each).

In September 2011 the prices of construction and assembly production were by 1.7% higher than in December of previous year and by 1.6% higher than in September of the previous year.

**in 2010-2011**

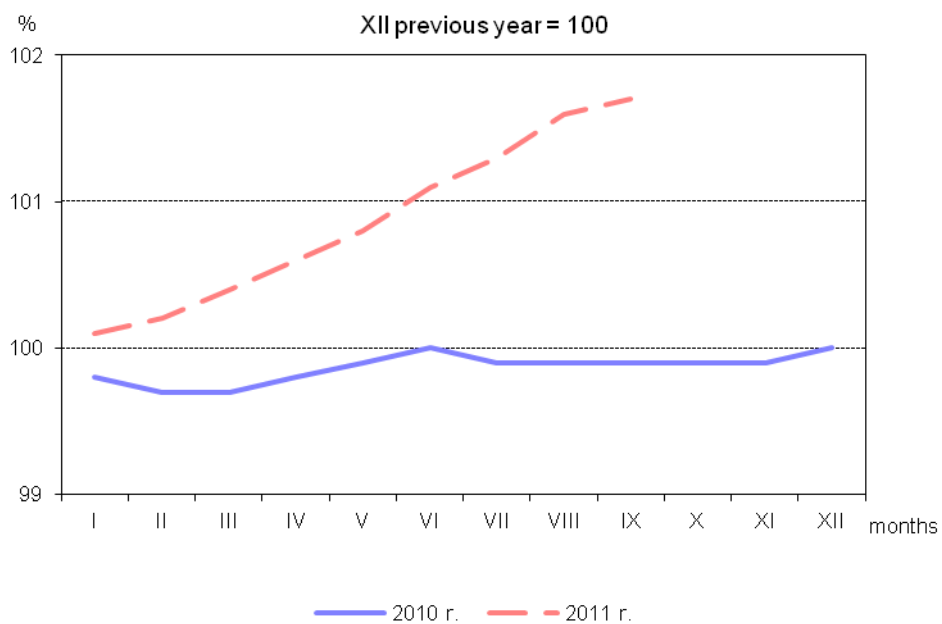

### Dynamics of prices in 2011 XII previous year = 100

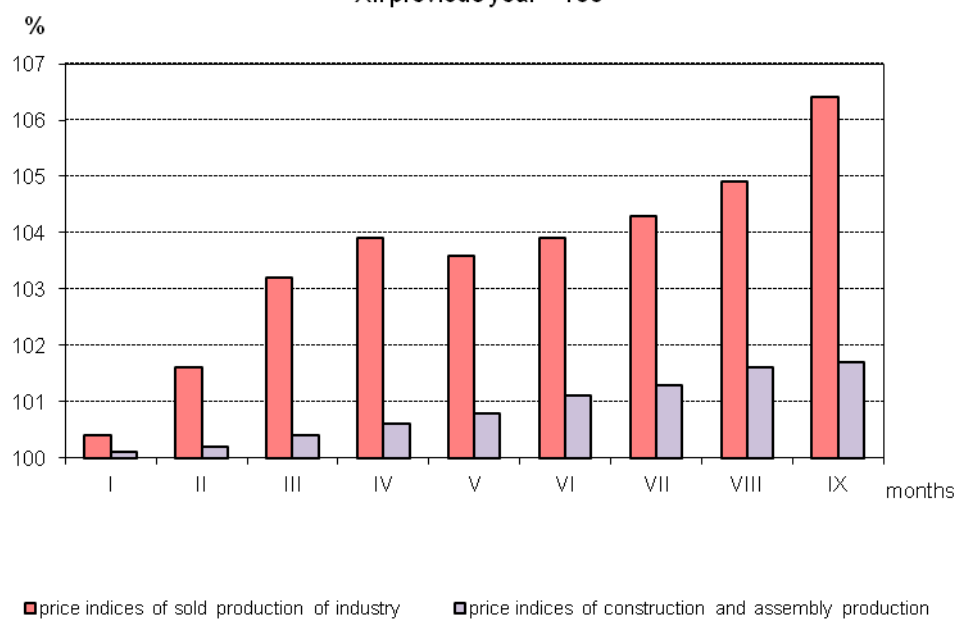
