According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in April of 2011 were by 0.8% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 4.4%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 8.4% as well as in mining of metal ores - by 0.4%. The increase of prices was recorded in manufacturing (by 0.7%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (by 3.7%). Prices were raised also in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 3.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 1.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.9%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.7%), of food products (by 0.6%), of textiles (by 0.5%), of metal products (by 0.3%), of paper and paper products, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.2% each). The prices in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the drop prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products, of electrical equipment, of pharmaceutical products (of 0.2% each), of furniture (of 0.3%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.4%), of tobacco products, of leather and related products (of 0.7% each), of beverages, of other transport equipment, of wearing apparel (of 0.8% each) as well as of machinery and equipment (of 1.0%). The increase of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.4%) but prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In April of 2011 the prices of sold production of industry were by 8.9% higher than a year earlier (against a drop of 0.4% a year earlier). The highest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 23.0%). The prices were also increased in sections: manufacturing (by 8.7%, against a drop of 1.9% a year earlier), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.8%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 3.7%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in April of 2011 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. A growth price was recorded in construction of buildings (by 0.2%, in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each).

In comparison to April of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 0.6% (against a drop of 0.3% a year earlier).

Fig. 1. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry in 2010-2011




Fig. 2. Dynamics of prices of construction and assembly production in 2010-2011



XII previous year = 100


