

Price indices of residential premises in the fourth quarter of 2023

3.0% Increase in prices of residential premises compared to the 4th guarter of 2022

In the fourth guarter of 2023 prices of residential premises in Poland, compared to the third guarter of 2023, increased by 4.8%. On the primary market the increase amounted 6.3% and on the secondary market – 3.3%. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2022, prices of residential premises increased by 13.0% (of which on the primary market - by 14.3% and on the secondary market - by 11.6%).

For compiling price indices of residential premises in 2023, the primary market is assigned a weight of 51.8% and the secondary market - 48.2%

In the fourth quarter of 2023 prices of residential premises were by 91.7% higher compared to the average price for 2015 (of which on the primary market – by 80.6% and on the secondary market – by 100.5%)

In the fourth quarter of 2023, the highest increase in prices of residential premises, compared to the previous quarter, was recorded in the Małopolskie Voivodship (by 7.9%), while a price decrease was observed in the Zachodniopomorskie Voivodship (by 0.4%)
