

Registrations and bankruptcies of enterprises in the third quarter of 2022

Increase in the number of registrations of enterprises in the third quarter of 2022 compared to the corresponding period of previous year In the third quarter of 2022, there were 93 970 registrations of enterprises recorded i.e. 10.3% more than in the corresponding period of previous year and 69 enterprises declared bankruptcy i.e. 12.7% less than in the corresponding period of previous year.

Registrations of enterprises

The number of registrations of enterprises in the third quarter of 2022 amounted to 93 970 compared to 85 198 in the corresponding period of previous year. In the third quarter of 2022, an increase in the number of registrations of enterprises was observed in most sectors: in information and communication (by 46.9%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 8.4%), services (by 7.8%), transportation and storage (by 6.3%), accommodation and catering (by 6.1%) and industry (by 5.5%). The decrease was recorded only in construction (by 0.8%). Regarding the legal forms, the greatest increase of registrations was noticed in the case of cooperatives (more than 4.5-fold increase) and the greatest decline was recorded for general partnerships (by 37.0%). In the third quarter of 2022, 85.4% of all registrations of enterprises concerned natural persons conducting economic activity and 12.4% limited liability companies (in the third quarter of 2021 the shares were 84.1% and 13.9%, respectively).





Chart 1. Number of registrations of enterprises

Chart 2. Structure of registrations of enterprises by legal form in the third quarter of 2022





Bankruptcies of enterprises

In the third quarter of 2022, a number of enterprises that declared bankruptcy amounted to 69 and was 12.7% lower than in the corresponding period of previous year. A decline in the number of entities that declared bankruptcy was recorded in trade; repair of motor vehicles (12 vs. 18), accommodation and catering (2 vs. 6), construction (6 vs. 8), industry (23 vs. 24), transportation and storage (2 vs. 3). An increase was noticed only in services (19 vs 18). The same number of bankruptcies as in the corresponding quarter of 2021 was recorded in information and communication.


In distinguished legal forms greater number of bankruptcies was recorded e.g. in limited liability companies (48 vs. 47) and limited partnerships (10 vs. 6) while smaller number of bankruptcies was recorded e.g. natural persons conducting economic activity (3 vs. 15), limited partnerships (4 vs. 8) and general partnerships (1 vs. 3). Among the enterprises for which bankruptcy was declared 69.6% were limited liability companies (compared to 59.5% in the third quarter of 2021) and 14.5% were limited partnerships (compared to 7.6% in the third quarter of 2021).

The data presented in this study are prepared in accordance with the guidelines developed by Eurostat and include information on registration and bankruptcy of enterprises (defined as a single legal unit) with a predominant type of activity classified as, according to NACE Rev. 2, sections from B (mining and quarrying) to S (other service activities), excluding section O (public administration and defence; compulsory social security) and division 94 (activities of membership organisations).

By legal form, the data include the: civil partnerships operating based on a contract concluded in accordance with the Civil Code, natural persons conducting economic activity, professional partnerships, public limited companies, simple joint stock companies, limited liability companies, general partnerships, limited partnerships, public limited partnerships, state enterprises, cooperatives, branches of foreign enterprises, companies provided for in provisions other than the Commercial Companies Code and the Civil Code or legal forms to which the provisions on companies apply, foreign enterprises, entities with no specific legal form.

In the study, there are additional forms of grouping introduced apart from the generally classification:

- "industry" including sections: mining and quarrying (section B), manufacturing (section C), electricity, gas steam and air conditioning supply (section D), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (section E);
- "services" including sections: financial and insurance activities (section K), real estate services (section L), professional, scientific and technical activities (section M), administrative and support service activities (section N);
- "other sections" including sections: education (section P), human health and social work activities (section Q), arts, entertainment and recreation (section R), other service activities (section S excluding division 94 activities of membership organisations).

The number of bankruptcies in a given quarter applies to enterprises against which a decision on declaration of bankruptcy has been issued by a competent District Court in a given quarter.

The number of registrations in a given quarter applies to enterprises that were registered in the National Official Registry of Entities of the National Economy (REGON) in a given quarter. The registrations also include natural persons that terminated than restarted economic activity.
