

The obligation to provide answers

Persons covered by the census and the test and control census are obliged to provide exact, exhaustive and true answers to the questions included in the questionnaire, subject to Art. 6 Section 3.

Adult persons are obliged to provide answers on behalf of minors who live with them, subject to Section 3.

In the case of data referred to in Art. 6 Section 3, answers shall be provided voluntarily.

Adult persons are obliged to provide answers on their absent co-tenants, subject to Section 5.

The obligation referred to in Section 4 does not involve data collected voluntarily, referred to in Art. 6 Section 3.

In collective accommodation facilities, if it is not possible to directly record a person's data, i.e. information on his/her surname and names, sex, date of birth, citizenship, the duration and reason of residence, and former residence and education, the relevant information shall be provided by the manager of such a facility.

Information on the buildings administered by legal persons and organisational units without legal personality is provided by the managers or administrators of such buildings.

Information on buildings owned by natural persons is provided by the owners, occupants, or administrators of such buildings.

Information on uninhabited apartments is provided by the managers or administrators of buildings in which these apartments are located.
