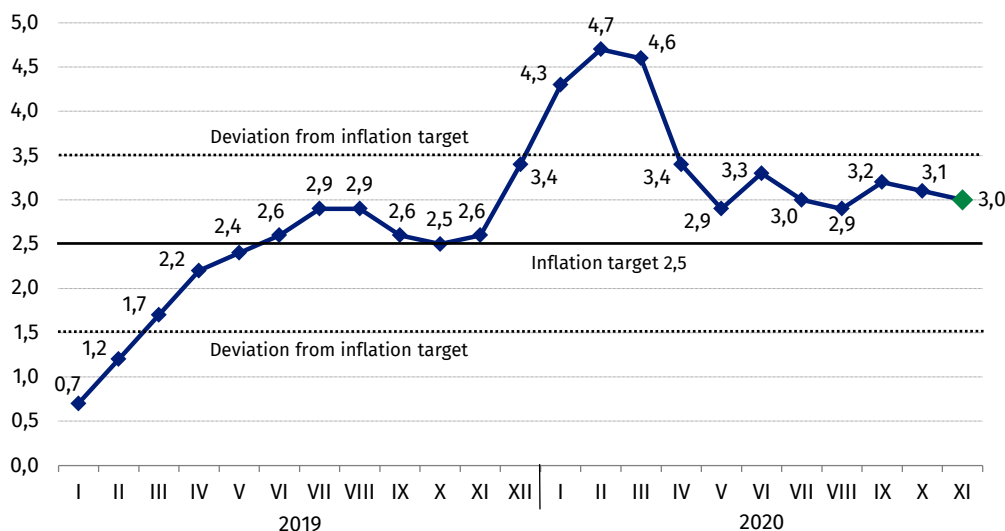

Consumer prices according to the flash estimate in November 2020, compared with the corresponding month of the previous year, increased by 3,0% (price index 103,0), and as related to the previous month remained at the same level (price index 100,0).
