

Price indices of residential premises in the fourth quarter of 2020




Prices of residential premises in the fourth quarter of 2020, compared to the third quarter of 2020, increased by 1.0% (of which on the primary market - by 1.7% and on the secondary market - by 0.5%). Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, prices of residential premises increased by 8.9% (of which on the primary market - by 6.0% and on the secondary market - by 11.2%).

Chart 2. Quarterly changes in prices of residential premises compared to the previous quarter




Chart 3. Quarterly changes in prices of residential premises compared to the corresponding quarter of the previous year





Chart 4. Quarterly changes in prices of residential premises compared to 2015



Prices of residential premises in the second quarter of 2020 were by 38.4% higher compared to the average price for 2015 (of which on the primary market – by 27.7% and on the secondary market – by 47.8%)

In the 4th quarter of 2020, compared to the 3rd quarter of 2020, the highest increase in prices of residential premises was recorded in the Lubuskie Voivodship (by 4.7%), but the decreases were in the Opolskie Voivodship, Podkarpackie Voivodship, Mazowieckie Voivodship and Małopolskie Voivodship
