Producer prices in industry and in construction in comparison to the previous month

According to preliminary data in January 2018 both the prices of sold production of industry and construction and assembly production were higher by 0.1%.

According to preliminary data in January 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 0.2% in comparison to January 2017. Higher prices increase was recorded in construction and assembly production – o 1.5%.

The prices of industry in January 2018 in annual terms growth by 0.2% and in construction by 1.5%

Among sections of industry in January in comparison to the previous month prices increase was recorded only in manufacturing, but in annual terms – in sections: manufacturing and water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities

The prices of sold production of industry

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in January 2018 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in manufacturing by 0.2%, of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.6%). The prices were also higher among other things in manufacture of basic metals (by 1.2%), of tobacco products (by 0.7%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.6%), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.5%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.4%), of paper and paper products, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of textiles (by 0.3% each), of electrical equipment (by 0.2%), of metal products, of wearing apparel (by 0.1% each). Prices in manufacture of rubber and plastic products reached the level similar to the one recorded in December 2017. The drop of prices were recorded among other things in manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products, beverages (of 0.1% each), of furniture (of 0.2%), of computer, electronic and optical products, of machinery and equipment (of 0.4% each), of food products (of 0.5%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.6%), of other transport equipment (of 0.8%), of leather and related products (of 0.9%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in December 2017. The drop of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply of 0.3%. The drop of prices was also recorded in mining and quarrying of 0.5%.

In January 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 0.2% higher than a year earlier. The biggest growth of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 1.0%. The growth of prices was also recorded in manufacturing by 0.2%, of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (by 4.9%) but also in manufacture of paper and paper products (by 2.7%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.4%), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.0%), of textiles (by 1.7%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 1.0%), of food products (by 0.8%), of beverages (by 0.7%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.5%) as well as of metal products (by 0.4%). In the scope of manufacturing the drop of prices was recorded among other things in manufacturing of machinery and equipment, of pharmaceutical products, of tobacco products (of 0.9% each), of rubber and plastic products, of furniture (of 1.1% each), of electrical equipment (of 1.2%), of textiles, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 1.3% each), of computer, electronic and optical products, of leather and related products (of 1.6% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 2.0%) as well as of other transport equipment (of 4.8%). In mining and quarrying the drop of prices was recorded of 0.3%, of which in mining of metal ores (of 2.5%) but the growth of prices was recorded in mining of coal and lignite (by 1.1%). The prices decreased in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - of 0.9%.

The prices of construction and assembly production

It is estimated that the prices of construction and assembly production in January 2018 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings, in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each).

In comparison to January of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production were higher by 1.5%. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings (by 1.8%), in specialised construction activities (by 1.7%) as well as in civil engineering (by 1.3%).

In January 2018 in comparison to the previous month the biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 1.6% (in comparison to January 2017 the increase was by 2.0%)

The biggest growth of prices in comparison to the January of the previous year was recorded in manufacture of basic metals by 4.9% (in comparison to the previous month the increase was by 1.2%)

Prices in construction in January 2018 in comparison to January 2017 increased in all divisions of construction

Chart 1. Dynamics of prices in 2017-2018 (XII 2016 = 100)

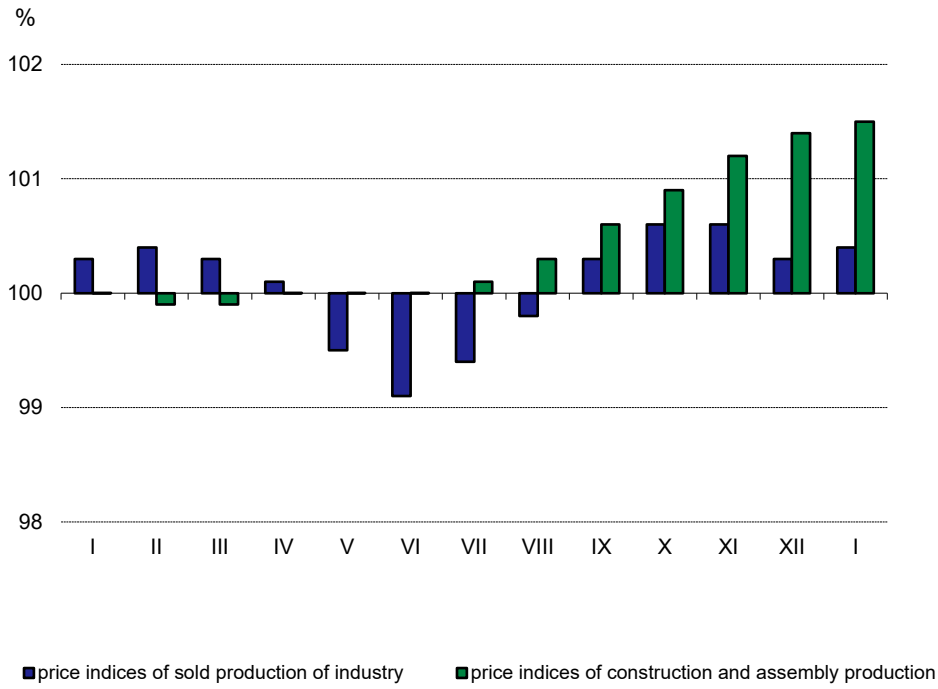
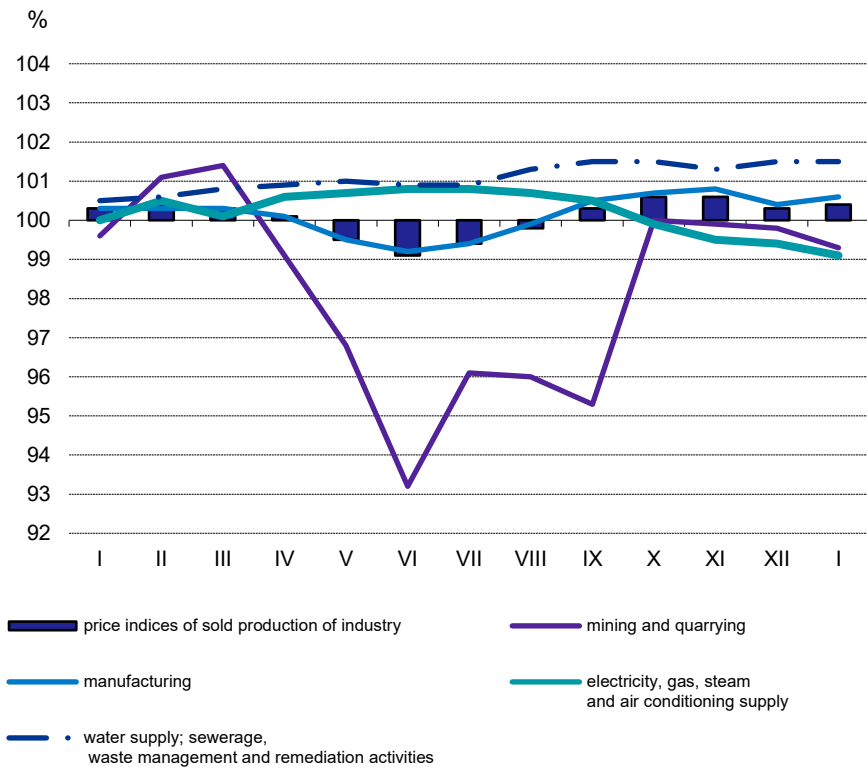


Chart 2. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry sections in 2017-2018 (XII 2016 = 100)
