Prices in industry in comparison to the previous month

According to preliminary data in March 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 0.4% higher in comparison to February 2018. The prices of construction and assembly production were higher by 0.2%.

The prices in construction in March 2018 were by 0.2% higher in comparison to the previous month

According to preliminary data in March 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 0.3% in comparison to March 2017. The prices increase was also recorded in construction and assembly production – by 1.8%.

The prices in industry in March 2018 in annual terms were higher by 0.3%, in construction – by 1.8%

In all industrial sections, with the exception water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities in March 2018 prices increased in comparison to the previous month this year, however in comparison to corresponding month of the previous year prices increase was recorded in sections: manufacturing as well as water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities

The prices of sold production of industry

According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in March 2018 were by 0.4% higher than in the previous month. The biggest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying by 1.6% of which in mining of coal and lignite (by 3.7%) but the drop of prices was recorded in mining of coal and lignite (of 1.2%). Higher were also prices in sections: manufacturing by 0.4% as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 0.1%. The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities were of 0.1% lower. In the scope of manufacturing the biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.8%). The prices were also higher in manufacture of beverages (by 1.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.6%), of other non-metallic mineral products, of paper and paper products (by 0.5% each), of rubber and plastic products, of basic metals (by 0.4% each), of electrical equipment, of other transport equipment, of wearing apparel (by 0.3% each), of food products, of metal products, of computer, electronic and optical products, of machinery and equipment, of furniture, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of leather and related products (by 0.2% each), of textiles (by 0.1%). The prices in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products reached the level similar to the one recorded in February 2018. The drop of prices were recorded among other things in printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.1%), in manufacture of pharmaceutical products as well as of tobacco products (of 0.4% each).

In March 2018 the prices of sold production of industry were by 0.3% higher than a year earlier. The growth of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 0.9%. The prices increased in manufacturing by 0.4%, in which the biggest in manufacturing of basic metals (by 5.0%). The growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of paper and paper products (by 4.6%), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 3.5%), of beverages (by 2.7%), of wearing apparel (by 2.4%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 2.2%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 1.9%), of metal products (by 0.5%). The prices in manufacture of food products as well as of tobacco products reached the level similar to the one recorded in March 2017. The drop of prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of electrical equipment (of 0.2%), of rubber and plastic products (of 0.3%), of leather and related products (of 0.5%), of machinery and equipment, of chemicals and chemical products (of 0.6% each), of textiles (of 0.7%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.8%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 0.9%), of furniture (of 1.1%), of pharmaceutical products (of 1.4%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 3.2%), as well as of other transport equipment (of 4.7%). The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying of 0.5%, of which in mining of metal ores (of 4.0%), but the growth of prices was recorded in mining of coal and lignite (by 0.4%). The prices decreased in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply of 0.6%.

The prices of construction and assembly production

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in March 2018 were by 0.2% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings, in civil engineering (by 0.2% each). The prices in specialised construction activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in February 2018.

In comparison to March of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production were higher by 1.8%. The growth of prices was recorded in construction of buildings (by 2.1%), in civil engineering (by 1.7%) as well as in specialised construction activities (by 1.6%).

In March 2018 in comparison to the previous month the biggest growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 1.8% (in comparison to March 2017 the growth was 3.5%)

The biggest growth of prices in comparison to the March of the previous year was recorded in manufacture of basic metals by 5.0% (in comparison to the previous month the growth was 0.4%)

Prices in construction in March 2018 in annual terms increased in all divisions of construction

Chart 1. Dynamics of prices in 2017-2018 (XII 2016 = 100)

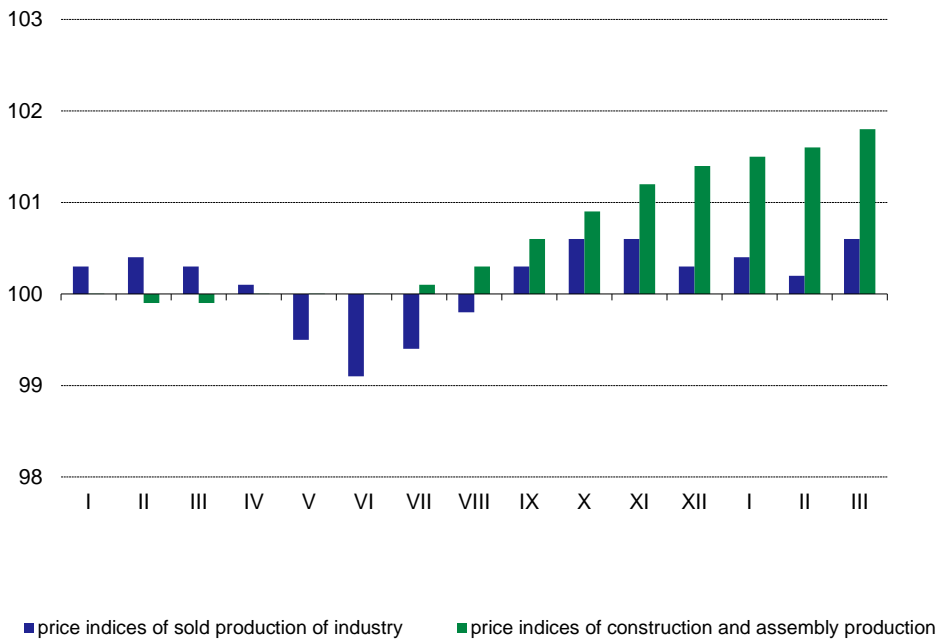
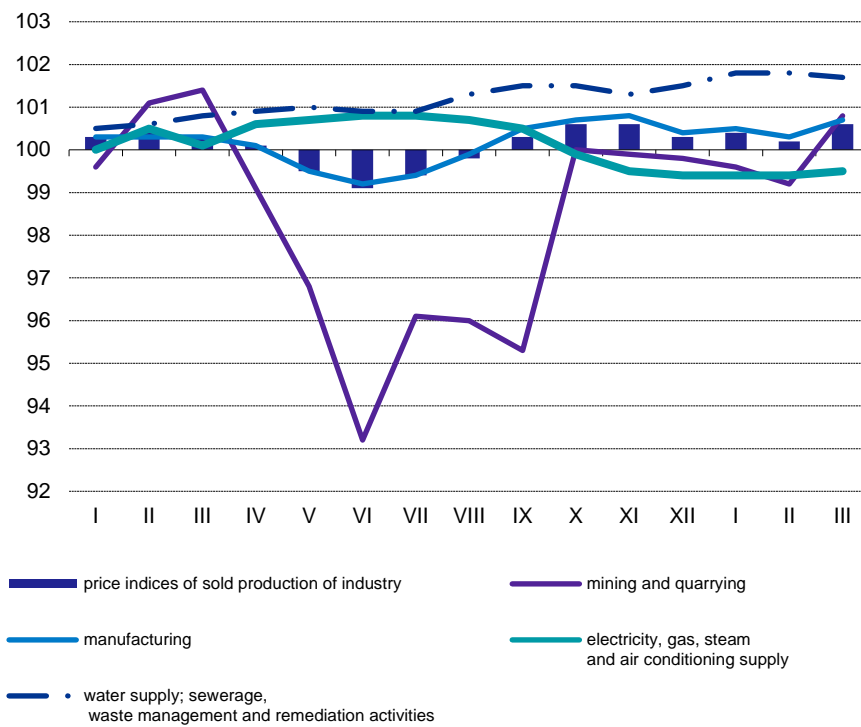


Chart 2. Dynamics of prices of sold production of industry sections in 2017-2018 (XII 2016 = 100)
