According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in March 2012 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The increase of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.5%). Prices in manufacturing grew by 0.2%, of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.7%). The growth of prices was recorded also among other things in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (by 1.1%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.9%), of beverages, of pharmaceutical products (by 0.5% each), of rubber and plastic products, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.3% each), of food products, other transport equipment (by 0.2% each) as well as of furniture (by 0.1%). However the prices were dropped among other things in manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products (of 0.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of machinery and equipment, of paper and paper products (of 0.2% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media, manufacture of leather and related products (of 0.4% each), of metal products (of 0.6%), of textiles, of wearing apparel (of 0.7% each), of basic metals, (of 0.8%) as well as of electrical equipment (of 1.0%). The increase of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.1%), however the drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 0.3%).

In March 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 4.5% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 5.4%). The prices were also increased in sections: mining and quarrying (by 4.8%), manufacturing (by 4.4%) as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 3.6%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in March 2012 reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.1%), however the growth prices was recorded in civil engineering and in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each).

In comparison to March the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 1.3% (against 0.6% a year earlier).

XII 2010 = 100

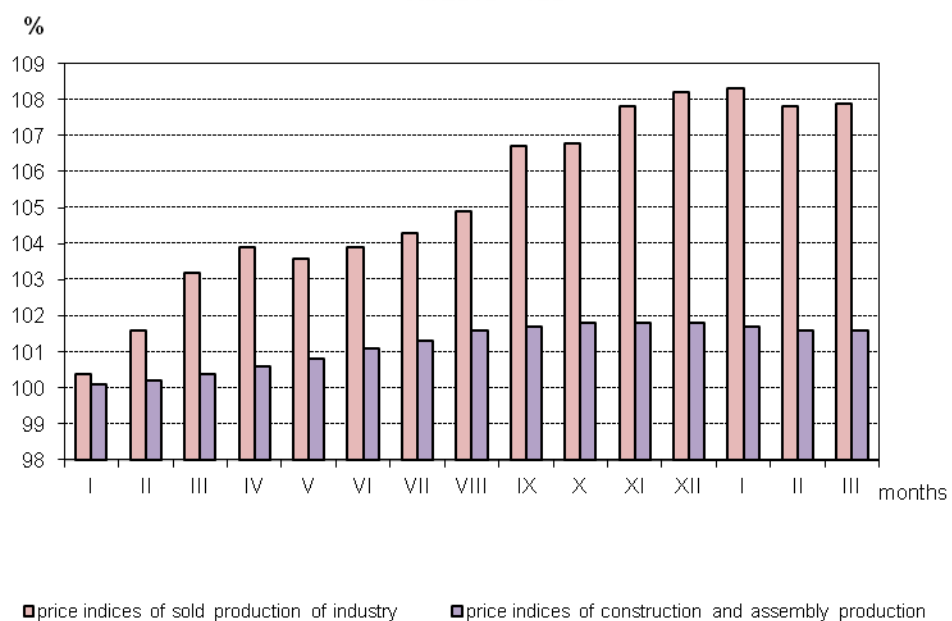
