According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in September 2012 were by 0.5% higher than in the previous month. The biggest growth of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 1.9%) of which mining of metal ores (by 5.6%), but in mining of coal and lignite prices reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The prices were also higher in manufacturing (by 0.4%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.4%). In manufacture among other things of chemicals and chemical products prices growth by 1.2%, of beverages by 1.0%, of food products, of rubber and plastic products by 0.6% each, of leather and related products by 0.5%, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of pharmaceutical products, of textiles by 0.4% each, of electrical equipment, of paper and paper products, of wearing apparel (by 0.3% each), of basic metals, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.2% each), of machinery and equipment by 0.1%. Prices in manufacture of metal products reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However, the prices drop was recorded among other things in manufacture of furniture (of 0.1%), of computer, electronic and optical products, (of 0.2%), of other transport equipment, of other non-metallic mineral products (of 0.4% each) as well as of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 1.0%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raise by 0.2% as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.1%.

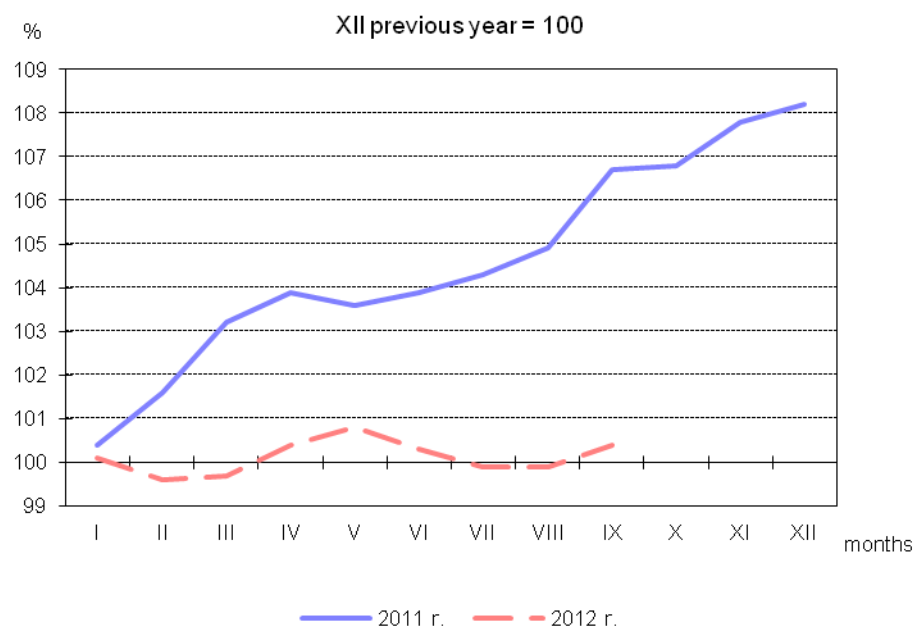
In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 0.4%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.7%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 3.0%. However the drop was recorded in the prices in manufacturing (of 0.2%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals and wearing apparel (of 3.9% each). Prices were lower also among other things of manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 3.0%), of manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (of 2.5%), of metal products (of 2.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.0%) as well as paper and paper products (of 1.7%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things of manufacture of food products (by 2.1%), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 4.3%), of pharmaceutical products (by 4.5%) as well as of beverages (by 4.8% each). The drop was recorded in the prices in mining and quarrying (of 1.7%), of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 3.5%), but the growth was recorded in mining of metal ores (by 0.2%).

In September 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 1.8% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.8%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 3.3%) as well as in manufacturing (by 1.5%). The drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 2.1%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in September 2012 were by 0.3% lower than in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.3%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.2% each).

In September 2012 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 1.1% lower than in December of previous year and by 0.7% lower than in September of the previous year.

**in 2011-2012**

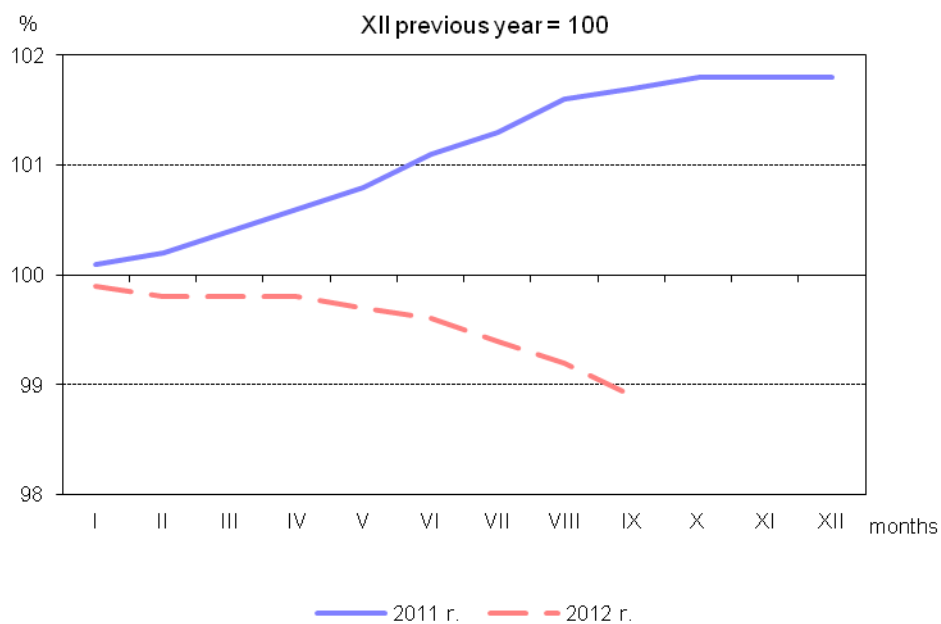
