According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in November 2012 were of 0.2% lower than in the previous month. The biggest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 1.0%) of which in mining of metal ores (of 2.3%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (of 0.3%) The prices were also lower in manufacturing (of 0.2%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (of 2.3%). In manufacture among other things of basic metals prices dropped of 1.1%, of computer, electronic and optical products of 0.8%, of machinery and equipment of 0.4%, of other non-metallic mineral products of 0.2%, of furniture as well as of wearing apparel of 0.1% each. The prices in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of metal products as well as of printing and reproduction of recorded media reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However, the prices growth was recorded among other things in manufacture of rubber and plastic products, of paper and paper products (by 0.1% each), of food products, of textiles (by 0.2% each), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.3%), of electrical equipment (by 0.4%), of other transport equipment (by 0.5%), of beverages (by 0.6%), of chemicals and chemical products, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.7% each), of leather and related products (by 0.8%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities fell of 0.1%, but in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply prices reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry was lower by 0.5% (against a growth of 7.8% a year earlier). The highest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 4.8%), of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 7.1%), as well as in mining of metal ores (of 3.3%). The drop was also recorded in the prices in manufacturing (of 1.0%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (of 5.7%). Prices were lower also among other things of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 4.0%), in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 3.8%), wearing apparel (of 3.7%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 3.6%), of other non-metallic mineral products (of 3.0%), of electrical equipment (of 2.1%), of metal products (of 2.0%), of coke and refined petroleum products (of 1.8%) as well as paper and paper products (of 1.6%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things of manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.2%), of food products (by 2.3%), of pharmaceutical products (by 3.0%) as well as of beverages (by 4.9%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 2.7% as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 5.7%.

In November 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were of 0.1% lower than a year earlier (against a growth by 9.1% in November 2011). The highest drop of prices was recorded in section mining and quarrying (of 3.5%) as well as in manufacturing (of 0.7%). The prices were increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 3.6%) and in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.7%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in November 2012 were of 0.2% lower than in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.3%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.1% each).

In November 2012 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 1.3% lower than in December of previous year and of 1.1% lower than in November of the previous year.

in 2011-2012

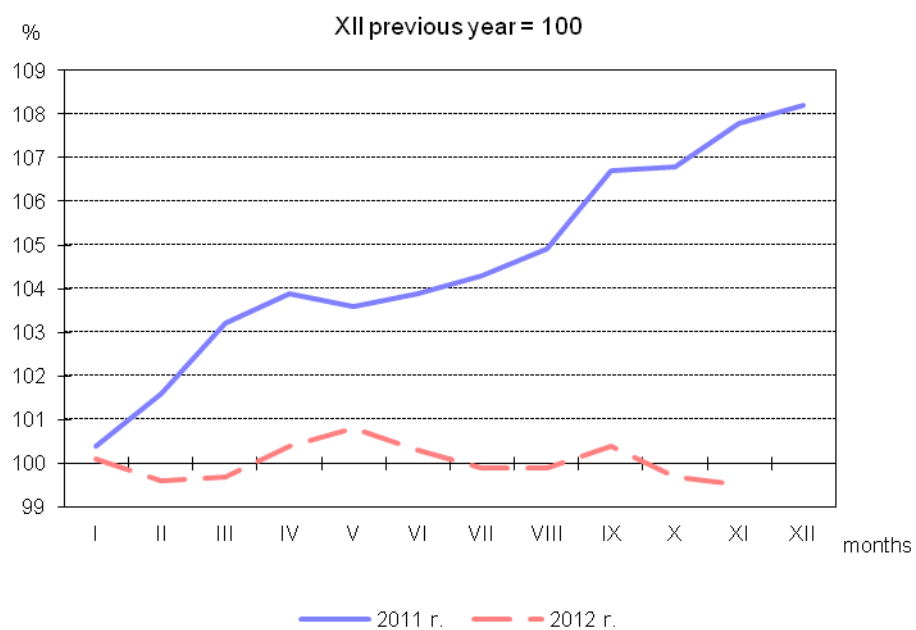

in 2011-2012

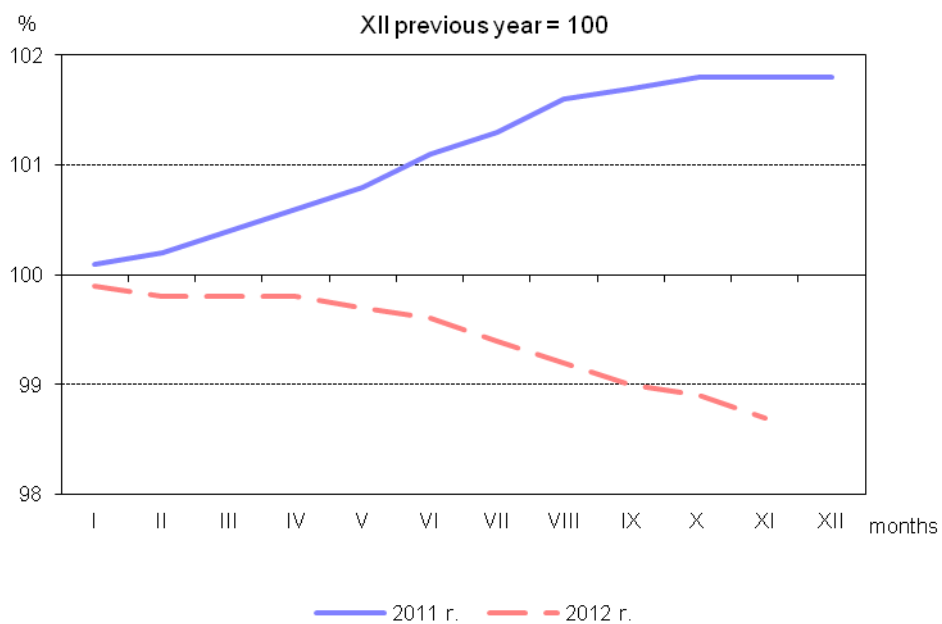

Dynamics of prices in 2012 XII previous year = 100

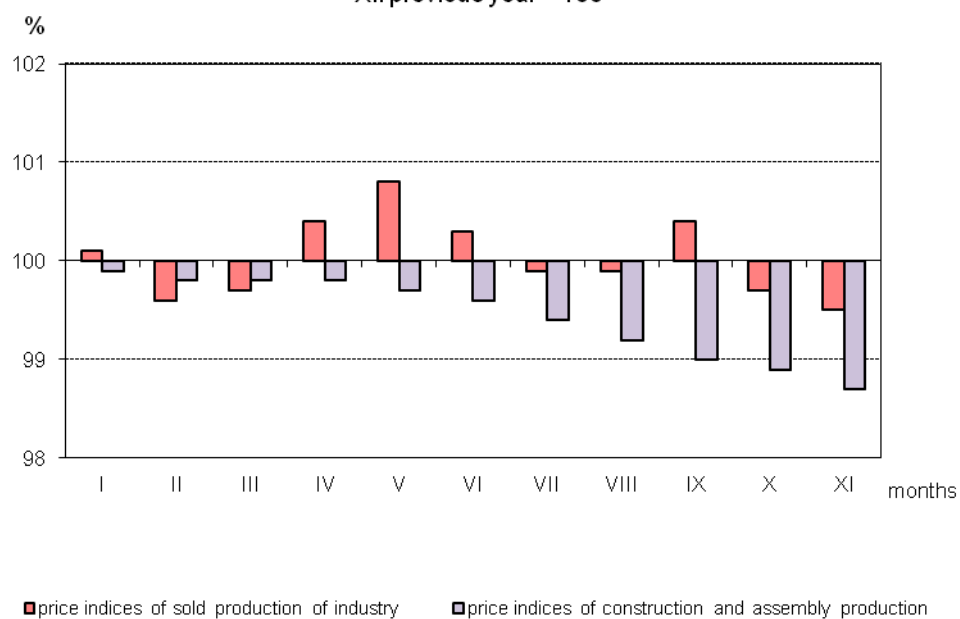
