According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in May 2012 were by 0.2% higher than in the previous month. Prices in manufacturing grew by 0.3%, of which in manufacture of other transport equipment (by 1.5%). The growth of prices was recorded also among other things in manufacture of paper and paper products (by 1.2%), of machinery and equipment, beverages (by 1.0% each), of metal products, of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.9% each), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.8%), of wearing apparel (by 0.7%), of food products, of electrical equipment, of textiles (by 0.6% each), of chemicals and chemical products, of basic metals, of furniture (by 0.5% each), of pharmaceutical products (by 0.4%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.2%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.1%). Prices of printing and reproduction of recorded media reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the prices were dropped among other things in manufacturing of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.1%), of leather and related products (of 0.2%) as well as of coke and refined petroleum products (of 2.0%). The increase of prices was recorded in sections mining and quarrying (by 0.2%) and in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.1%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities were lower of 0.2%.

In May 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 5.0% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 7.3%). The prices were also increased in sections: manufacturing (by 4.9%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.6%) as well as in mining and quarrying (by 0.8%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in May 2012 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. A drop price was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.1%). The prices of civil engineering as well as of specialised construction activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to May the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 0.9%.

in 2011-2012

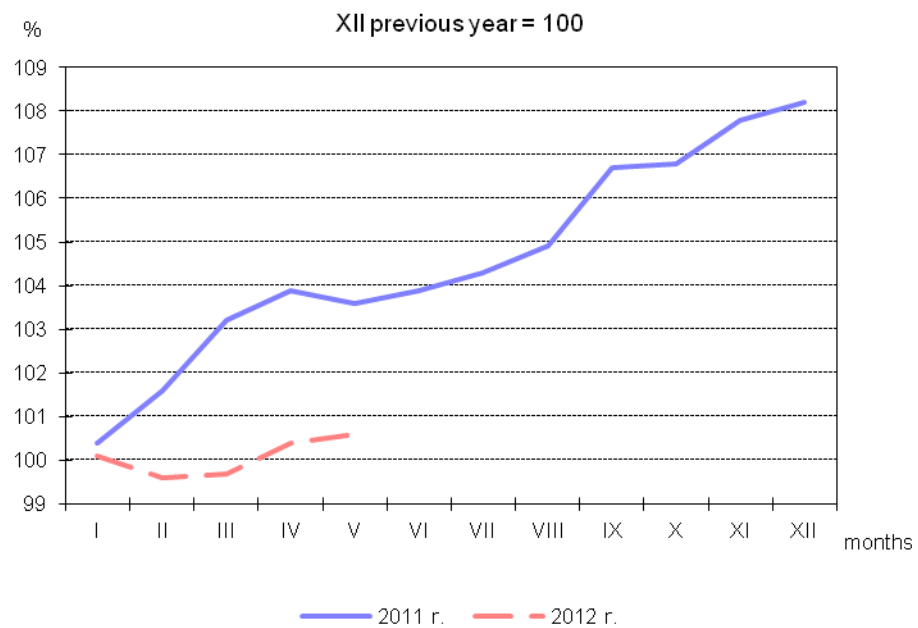

in 2011-2012

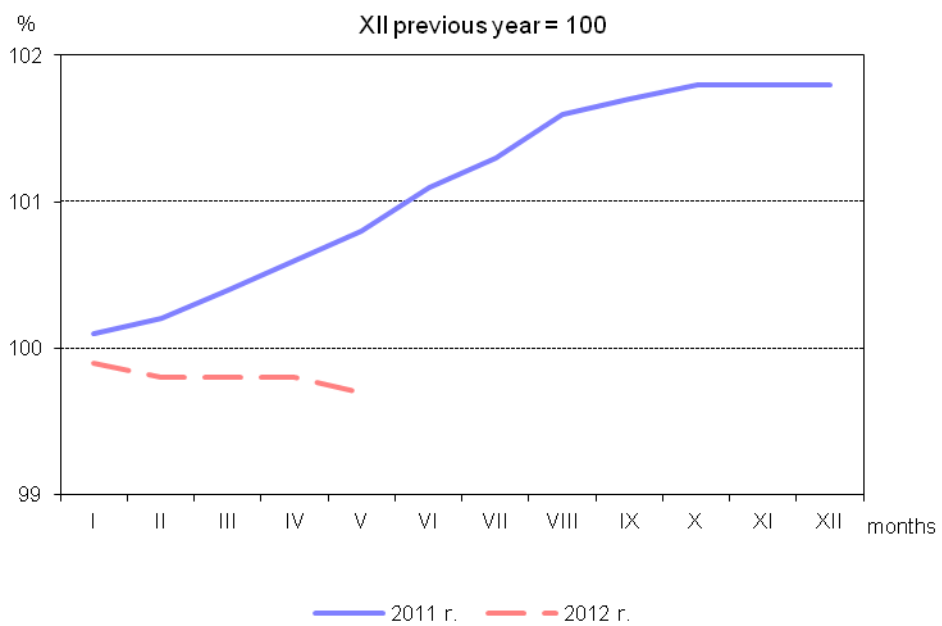
