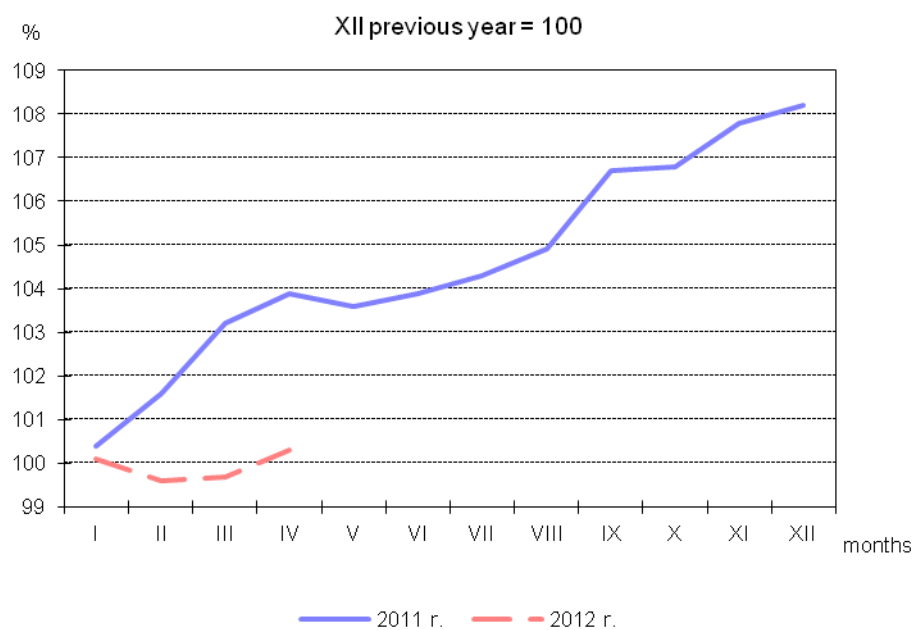
According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in April 2012 were by 0.6% higher than in the previous month. The increase of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 3.5%). Prices in manufacturing grew by 0.4%, of which in manufacture of basic metals by 2.3%. The growth of prices was recorded also among other things in manufacture of beverages (by 1.0%), of textiles (by 0.9%), of chemicals and chemical products, of rubber and plastic products (by 0.7% each), of machinery and equipment, of paper and paper products, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.6% each), coke and refined petroleum products, of other non-metallic mineral products, of computer, electronic and optical products, of leather and related products (by 0.4% each), of electrical equipment, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.3% each), of food products, of metal products (by 0.2% each), of furniture as well as other transport equipment (by 0.1% each). Prices of wearing apparel reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the prices were dropped among other things in manufacturing of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers as well as of pharmaceutical products (of 0.2% each). The prices of water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the March 2012. The prices in mining and quarrying was lower (of 1.3%).

In April 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 4.3% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 7.2%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 5.1%) as well as in manufacturing (by 4.2%). However the drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (by 1.0%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in April 2012 reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The growth prices was recorded in civil engineering and in specialised construction activities (by 0.1% each). Prices of construction of buildings reached the level similar to the one recorded in the March 2012.

In comparison to April the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 1.1%.

**in 2011-2012**

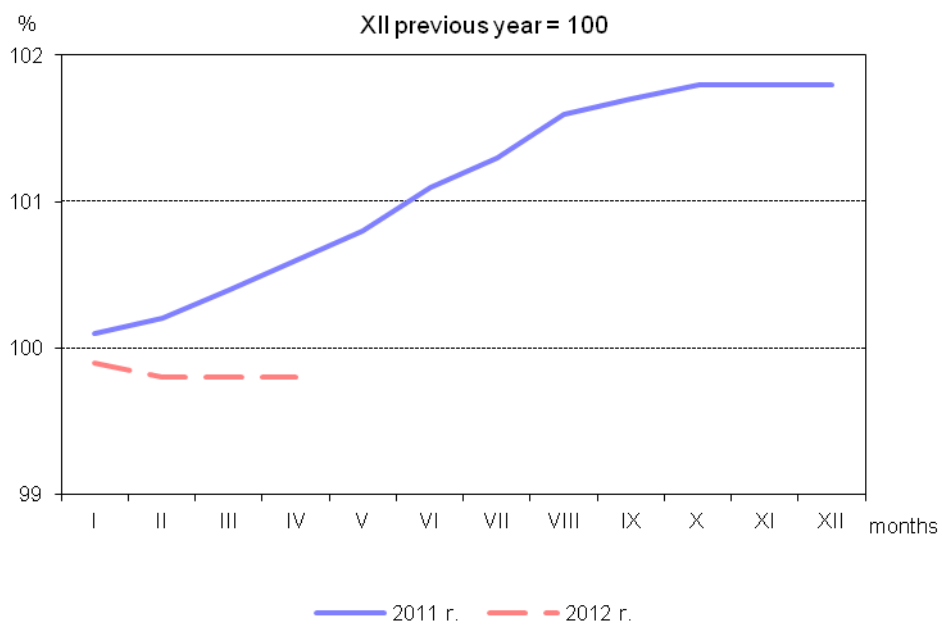
