According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in October 2012 were of 0.7% lower than in the previous month. The biggest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 2.2%) of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 3.3%) as well as in mining of metal ores (of 1.5%). The prices were also lower in manufacturing (of 0.7%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 4.1%). In manufacture among other things of basic metals prices dropped of 1.3%, of printing and reproduction of recorded media of 1.2%, in manufacture of pharmaceutical products of 0.9%, of computer, electronic and optical products of 0.8%, of beverages of 0.6%, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of leather and related products of 0.5% each, of chemicals and chemical products of 0.4%, of rubber and plastic products, of electrical equipment, of furniture of 0.3% each, of other non-metallic mineral products, of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of other transport equipment of 0.2%, of textiles as well as of wearing apparel of 0.1% each. However, the prices growth was recorded among other things in manufacture of food products, of paper and paper products (by 0.1% each), of metal products as well as of machinery and equipment (by 0.3% each). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities fell of 0.3%, but in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply was recorded growth by 0.1%.

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry was lower by 0.3%. The highest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 3.7%), of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 6.6%), as well as in mining of metal ores (of 1.0%). The drop was also recorded in the prices in manufacturing (of 0.8%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (of 4.8%). Prices were lower also among other things of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 3.8%), manufacture of wearing apparel (of 3.6%), motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 3.5%), of manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (of 2.8%), of electrical equipment (of 2.7%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 2.4%), of metal products (of 1.8%), as well as paper and paper products (of 1.6%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things of manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.4%), of food products (by 2.3%), of pharmaceutical products (by 3.0%) as well as of beverages (by 4.4%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 2.7% as well as in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 5.8%.

In October 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 1.0% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.9%). The prices were also increased in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 3.5%) as well as in manufacturing (by 0.4%). The drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 0.5%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in October 2012 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.3%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.1% each).

In October 2012 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 1.1% lower than in December of previous year and of 0.9% lower than in October of the previous year.

in 2011-2012

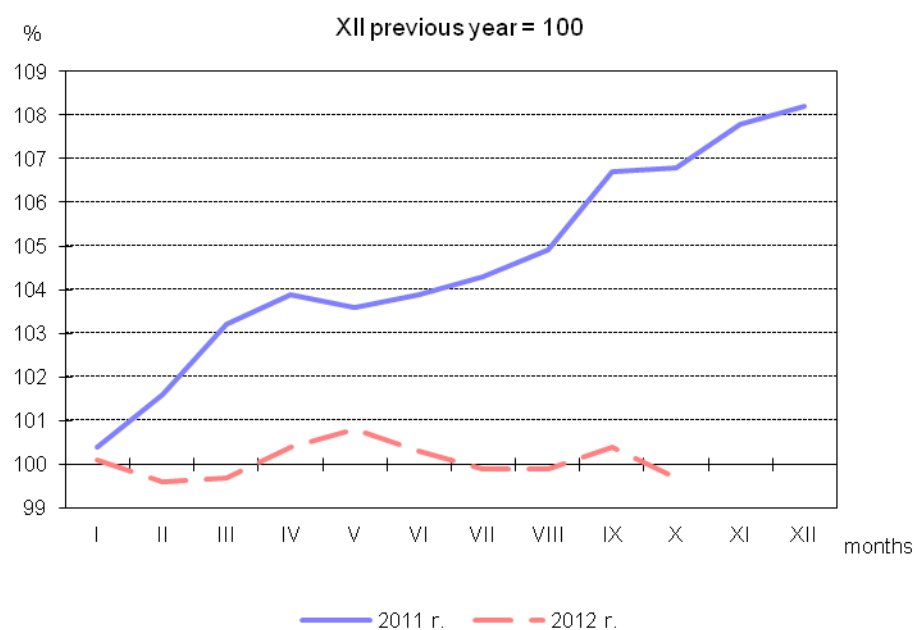

in 2011-2012

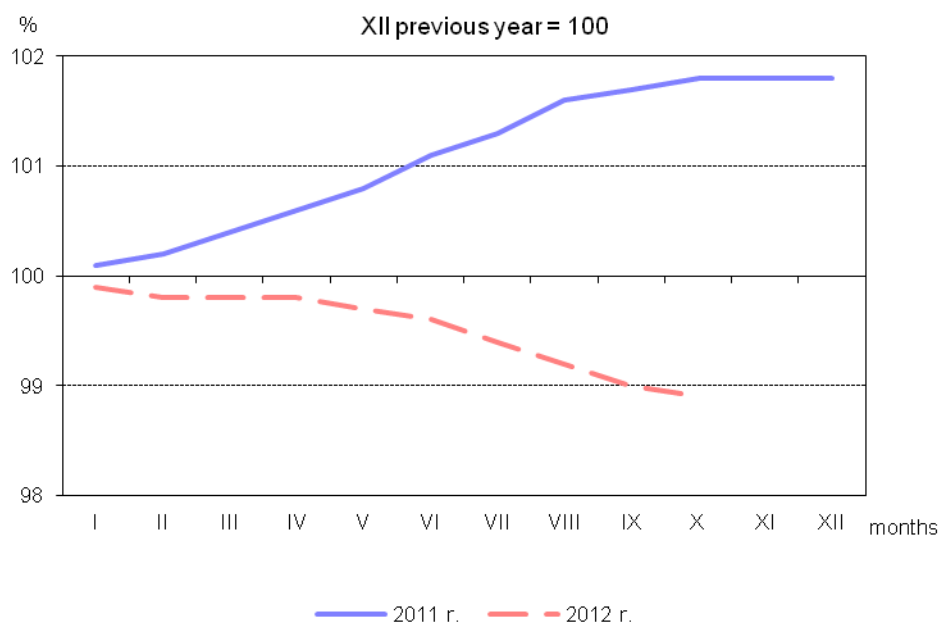

Dynamics of prices in 2012 XII previous year = 100

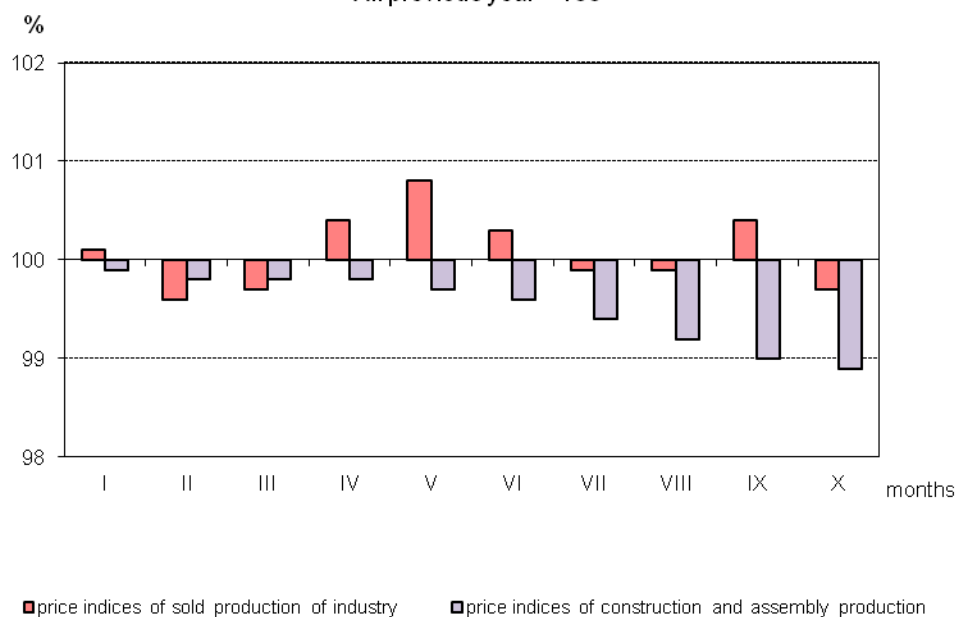
