According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in August 2012 were by 0.1% higher than in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.3%). The prices were also higher in manufacturing (by 0.2%), of which in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 4.1%). In manufacture among other things of pharmaceutical products price growth by 2.0%, of beverages by 0.7%, of food products, of leather and related products by 0.3% each. However, the drop was recorded among other things in the prices of rubber and plastic products, of wearing apparel (of 0.2% each), of chemicals and chemical products, of paper and paper products, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.3% each), of furniture (of 0.4%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of metal products, of other non-metallic mineral products, of other transport equipment, of textiles (of 0.6% each), of computer, electronic and optical products, of machinery and equipment (of 0.7% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.9%), of electrical equipment (of 1.2%) as well as of basic metals (of 1.3%). The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 1.2%).

In August 2012 the prices of sold production of industry reached the level similar to the one recorded in the December of the previous year. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.6%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 2.7%. However the drop was recorded in the prices in manufacturing (of 0.5%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (of 4.2%). Prices were lower also among other things of manufacture of wearing apparel (of 4.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 3.3%), of electrical equipment (of 2.5%), of metal products (of 2.2%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.1%), of manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (of 2.0%) as well as paper and paper products (of 1.7%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things of manufacture of food products (by 1.4%), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.9%), of pharmaceutical products as well as of beverages (by 3.8% each). The drop was recorded in the prices in mining and quarrying (of 3.3%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 5.1%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (of 3.4%).

In August 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 3.1% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.8%). The prices were also increased in sections: manufacturing (by 3.1%) as well as in water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 3.0%). The drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 2.9%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in August 2012 were by 0.2% lower than in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.3%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.1% each).

In August 2012 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 0.8% lower than in December of previous year and by 0.3% lower than in August of the previous year.

in 2011-2012

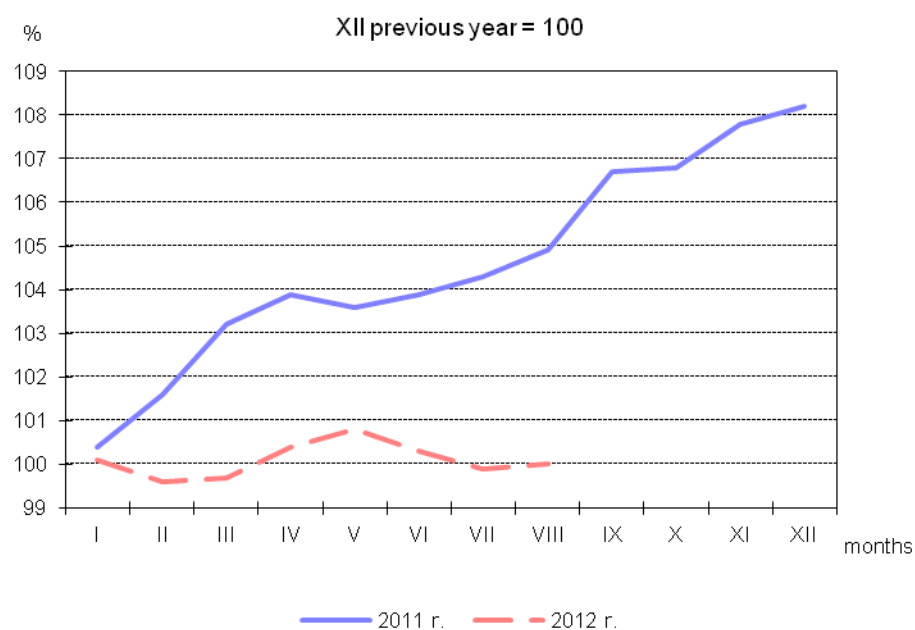

in 2011-2012

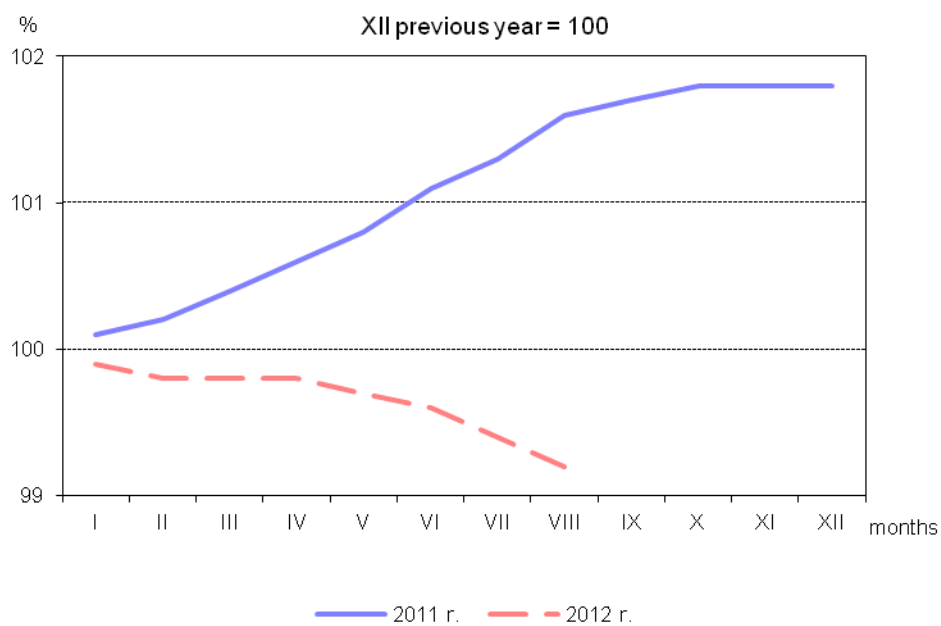

XII previous year = 100

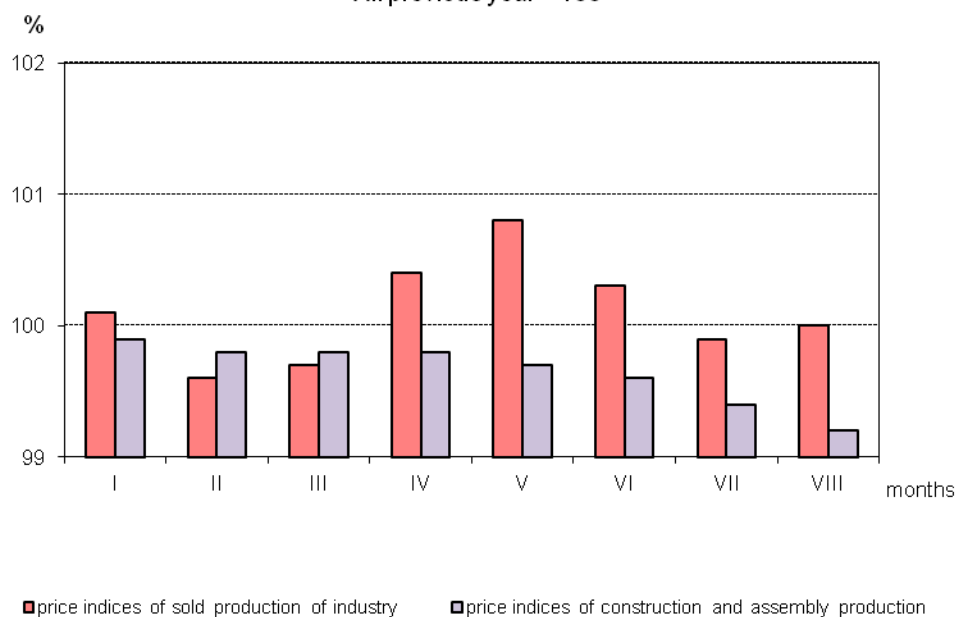
