According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in February of 2012 were by 0.3% lower than in the previous month. The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 0.8%), of which in mining of metal ores (of 1.1%) as well as in mining of coal and lignite (of 0.6%). Prices in manufacturing dropped of 0.4%, of which in manufacture of other transport equipment (of 1.4%). The drop of prices was recorded also among other things in manufacture of wearing apparel (of 1.3%), of machinery and equipment, of paper and paper products (of 1.1% each), of rubber and plastic products (of 1.0%), of computer, electronic and optical products, of furniture (of 0.9% each), basic metals, of pharmaceutical products (of 0.8% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of metal products, of electrical equipment (of 0.6% each), of other non-metallic mineral products, of textiles (of 0.5% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.4%), of leather and related products (of 0.3%), of chemicals and chemical products (of 0.2%). However the prices were raised among other things in manufacturing of coke and refined petroleum products (by 0.1%), of food products (by 0.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.4%) as well as of beverages (by 0.5%). The increase of prices was recorded in sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 0.2%) as well as in water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.5%).

In February of 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 6.3% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded manufacturing (by 6.6%) The prices were also increased in sections: mining and quarrying (by 5.0%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.5%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 3.6%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in February of 2012 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. The same drop price was recorded in construction of buildings, of civil engineering as well as of specialised construction activities.

In comparison to February of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 1.4% (against 0.4% a year earlier).

XII 2010 = 100

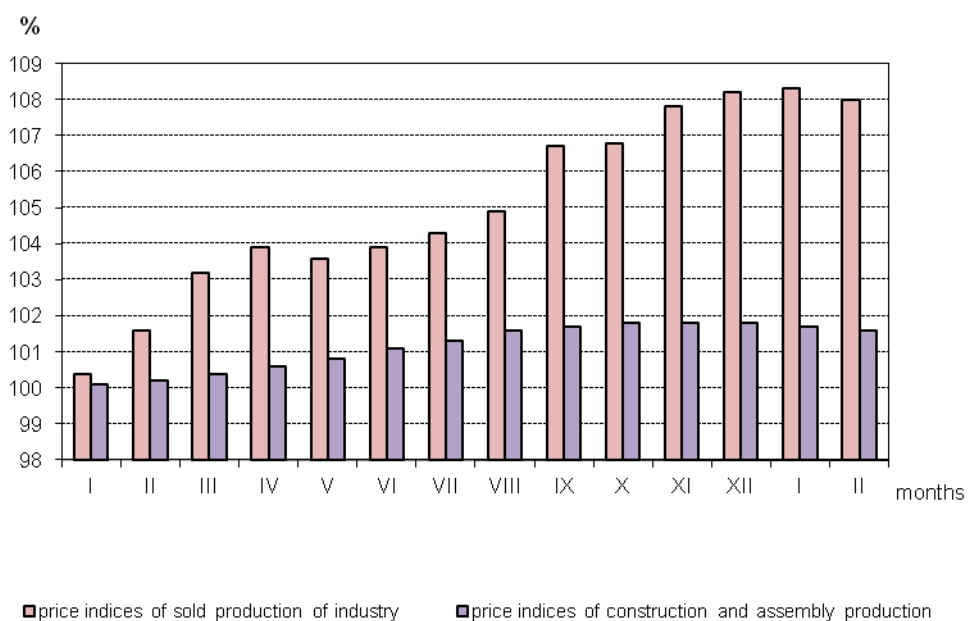
