According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in July of 2012 were by 0.2% lower than in the previous month. The drop of prices was recorded in manufacturing (of 0.2%), of which in manufacture of basic metals (of 1.9%). The prices were also lower in manufacture among other things of paper and paper products (of 0.9%), of chemicals and chemical products, of machinery and equipment, of pharmaceutical products, of textiles (of 0.8% each), of metal products, of rubber and plastic products, of computer, electronic and optical products, of wearing apparel (of 0.6% each), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of other non-metallic mineral products, of electrical equipment (of 0.5% each), of beverages, of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.3% each), of food products (of 0.2%) as well as of other transport equipment (of 0.1%). However, the growth was recorded among other things in the prices of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.2%), of furniture (by 0.3%), of leather and related products (by 0.4%) as well as of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.1%). The prices in section mining and quarrying as well as water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply growth by 0.1%.

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry raised by 0.1%. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.6%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities raised by 2.4%. However the drop was recorded in the prices in manufacturing (of 0.5%), of which the biggest in manufacture of wearing apparel (of 3.7%). Prices were lower also among other things of manufacture of basic metals (of 2.8%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.3% each), manufacture of metal products (of 1.5%), of coke and refined petroleum products (of 1.3%), of other non-metallic mineral products, of electrical equipment (of 1.1% each), as well as of paper and paper products (of 1.0%). The growth of prices was recorded among other things of manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.7%), of furniture (by 1.3%), of food products, of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.4% each), of pharmaceutical products (by 1.9%) as well as of beverages (by 3.0%). The drop was recorded in the prices in mining and quarrying (of 2.2%), of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 2.9%) as well as in mining of metal ores (of 2.5%).

In July 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 3.7% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 6.3%). The prices were also increased in sections: manufacturing (by 3.8%) as well as in water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 2.9%). The drop prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 2.7%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in July 2012 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. The drop prices was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.2%), in civil engineering as well as in specialised construction activities (of 0.1% each).

In July 2012 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 0.5% lower than in December of previous year and by 0.1% higher than in July of the previous year.

in 2011-2012

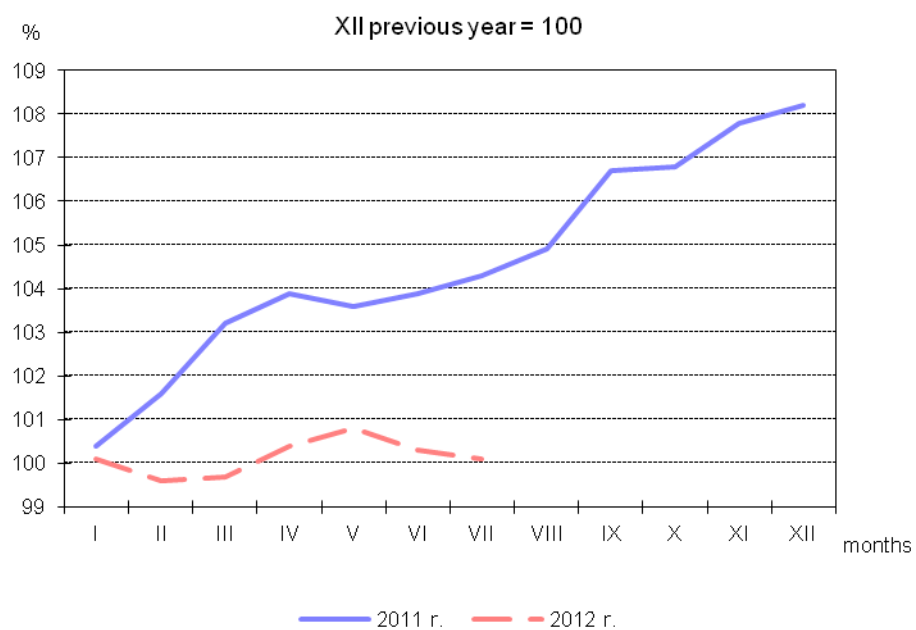

in 2011-2012

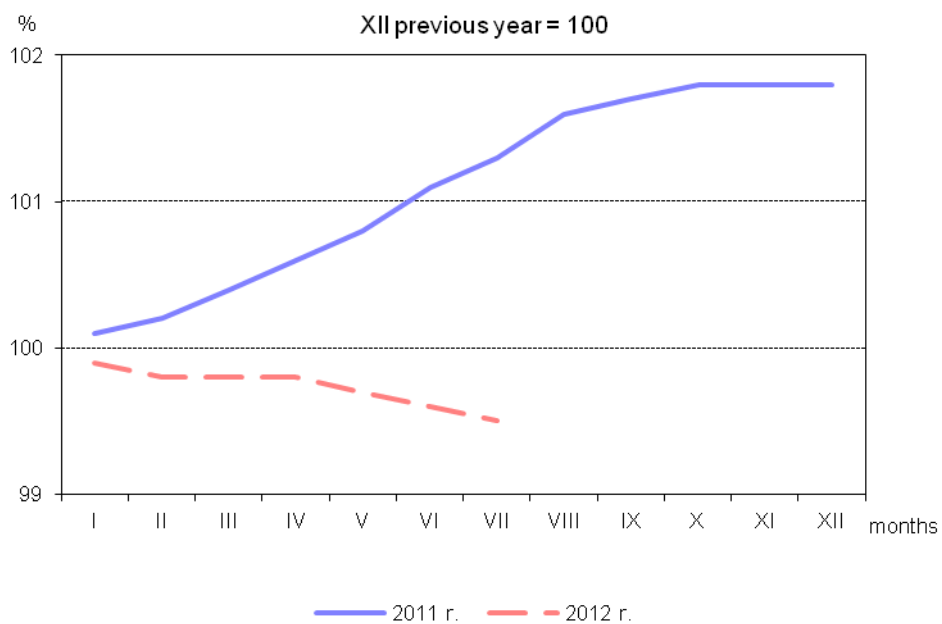
