According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in 2012 with relation to previous year grew by 3.3% (against 7.6% in 2011). The highest growth of prices was recorded in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.7%). The increase of prices was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 3.9%) as well as in manufacturing (by 3.2%). The drop was recorded in mining and quarrying of 0.3% (against growth by 16.8% in 2011).

It is estimated that in December of 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were of 1.1% lower than in the previous year. The highest drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying (of 5.9%), of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 8.5%) as well as in mining of metal ores (of 4.3%). The drop was also recorded in manufacturing (of 1.7%), of which the biggest in manufacture of basic metals (of 6.4%). Lower than in December of previous year were also prices among other things in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (of 5.7%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 4.3%), of wearing apparel (of 4.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 3.6%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 3.2%), of manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (of 3.1%), of electrical equipment (of 3.0%), of metal products (of 2.0%), of paper and paper products, of other transport equipment (of 1.7% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 1.0%), of furniture (of 0.8%), of machinery and equipment, of textiles (of 0.4% each), of rubber and plastic products (of 0.2%). Higher than in December of previous year were prices among other things in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.0%), of leather and related products (by 1.1%), of food products (by 2.3%), of beverages (by 3.1%) as well as of pharmaceutical products (by 4.1%). The growth was recorded in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 2.8%) and in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 5.7%).

It is estimated that **the prices of construction and assembly production** in 2012 were by 0.2% higher than in the previous year. The growth prices was recorded in the prices in specialised construction (by 0.5%), in civil engineering (by 0.4%). The drop was recorded in construction of buildings (of 0.2%).

The prices of construction and assembly production in December of 2012 were by 1.4% lower than the one recorded in the previous year. The drop was recorded in the prices in construction of buildings (of 2.2%), in specialised construction as well as in civil engineering (of 0.8% each).

in 2011-2012

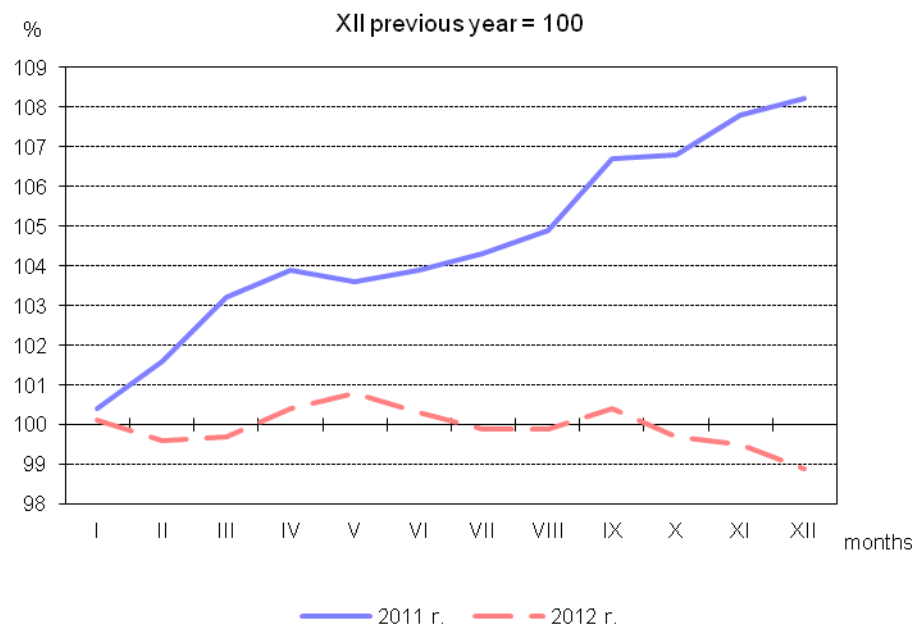

in 2011-2012

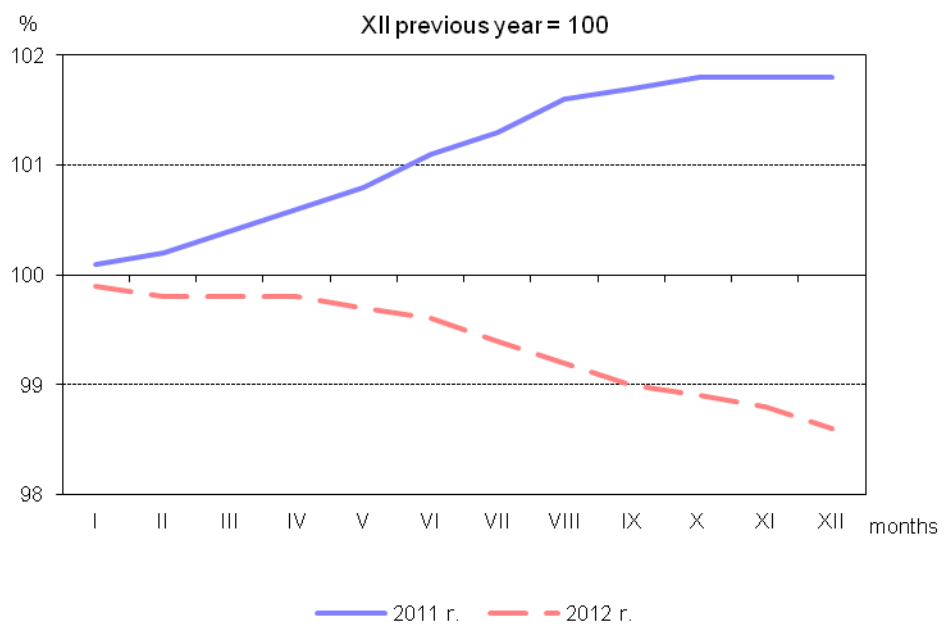

XII previous year = 100

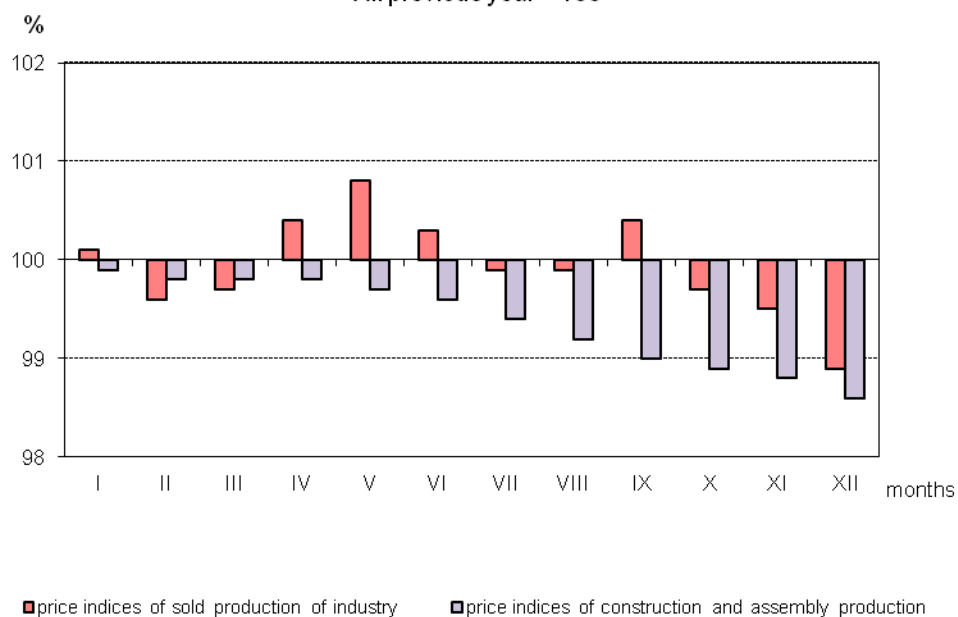
