According to preliminary data, **the prices of sold production of industry** in January of 2012 were by 0.2% higher than in the previous month. The increase of prices was recorded in sections: mining and quarrying, water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 1.7% each) as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 1.2%). Prices in manufacturing dropped of 0.1%, of which in manufacture of basic metals (of 1.4%). The drop of prices was recorded also among other things in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 1.3%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 1.1%), of paper and paper products, of wearing apparel (of 1.0% each), of leather and related products (of 0.8%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.6%), of beverages (of 0.5%), of metal products (of 0.3%), of other transport equipment (of 0.2%), of electrical equipment, of computer, electronic and optical products, of other non-metallic mineral products as well as of furniture (of 0.1% each). The prices of chemicals and chemical products reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. However the prices were raised in manufacturing of machinery and equipment (by 0.1%), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.2%), of food products, of textiles (by 0.3% each), pharmaceutical products (by 1.6%) as well as of coke and refined petroleum products (by 2.1%).

In January of 2012 the prices of sold production of industry were by 8.0% higher than a year earlier. The highest growth of prices was recorded manufacturing (by 8.6%) The prices were also increased in sections: mining and quarrying (by 7.7%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 4.0%) as well as electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 3.4%).

It is estimated that the **prices of construction and assembly production** in January of 2012 were by 0.1% lower than in the previous month. A drop price was recorded in construction of buildings as well as in of civil engineering (of 0.1% each). The prices of specialised construction activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In comparison to January of the previous year, the prices of construction and assembly production growth by 1.5% (against 0.3% a year earlier).

XII 2010 = 100

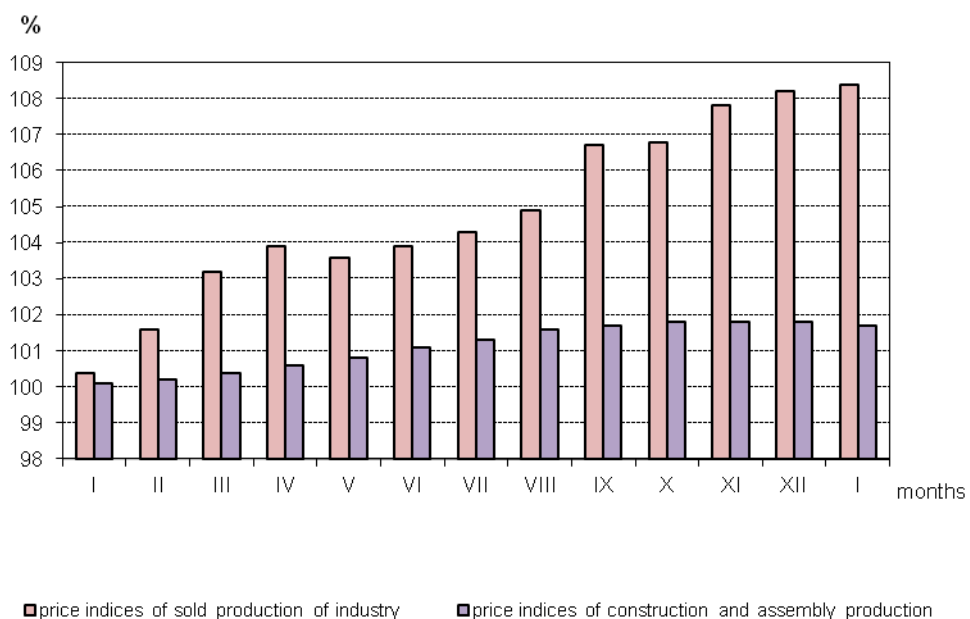
