

Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by countries in 2023

Foreign trade turnover in 2023 according to final data in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 1 613.4 bn, while in imports - PLN 1568.3 bn. The positive balance reached the level of PLN 45.1 bn, while in 2022 year was negative and amounted to PLN 93.2 bn. In comparison to 2022 exports decreased by 0.3%, while imports by 8.4%.

Foreign trade turnover expressed in US dollars and in EUR

Exports expressed in USD amounted to 381.9 bn, while imports amounted to USD 371.4 bn (an increase in exports of 4.4% and a decrease in imports of 4.0%). The positive balance reached the level of USD 10.5 bn, while in 2022 year amounted to minus USD 21.2 bn.

Exports expressed in EUR amounted to 353.1 bn, while imports amounted to EUR 343.3 bn (an increase in exports of 2.0% and in imports a decrease of 6.3 %). The positive balance reached EUR 9.8 bn, compared to a negative balance of EUR 20.0 bn in 2022.

Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by groups of countries

Poland has the largest share in total exports with the developed countries – 86.6% (of which EU 74.9%) and in imports – 66.0% (of which EU 54.0%), in comparison with 87.3% (of which EU 75.8%) and 62.2% (of which EU 51.4%) in 2022. However, the smallest share was observed with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, which in total exports amounted to 5.1%, and in imports – 2.2%, in comparison with 4.8% and 6.2% in 2022.

The negative balance was recorded with the developing countries – minus PLN 365.4 bn (minus USD 86.5 bn, minus EUR 80.0 bn). The positive balance was obtained in turnover with the developed countries PLN 362.3 bn (USD 85.5 bn, EUR 79.1 bn), of which with the EU countries the balance of PLN 360.7 bn (USD 85.2 bn, EUR 78.8 bn) and with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe minus PLN 48.1 bn (minus USD 11.5 bn, minus EUR 10.6 bn).

Note. Due to the rounding of data, in some cases sums of components may slightly differ from the amount given in the item "total".

Foreign trade turnover by major countries

In 2023, among the main trade partners of Poland decreases in exports compared to 2022 were recorded with Slovakia (by 5.9%), Czechia (by 4.9%), and the Netherlands (by 2.2%). However, declines in imports were recorded with China (by 13.8%), Germany (by 9.6%), the United States (by 6.9%), Belgium (by 5.7%), Italy (by 4.0%), Czechia (by 2.9%), and the Netherlands (by 2.1%).

The turnover with the top ten of Polish trade partners in exports accounted for 66.2% (65.6% in 2022), while in total imports – 61.2% (in comparison with 59.6% in 2022).

The share of Germany in exports amounted to 27.9% and remained unchanged in comparison to 2022 year and in imports decreased by 0.3 pp and accounted for 19.9%. The positive balance amounted to PLN 138.8 bn (USD 32.8 bn, EUR 30.3 bn) in comparison with PLN 105.6 bn (USD 23.7 bn, EUR 22.5 bn) in 2022.

¹ Country of origin is the country where the commodity was produced or processed and in this form entered the Polish customs zone.

Imports by country of consignment – total and groups of counties

The highest turnover in imports by country of consignment Poland recorded with the developed countries - PLN 1202.3 bn, of which with the EU - PLN 1069.5 bn, compared to PLN 1299.9 bn, of which with the EU - PLN 1097.9 bn in 2022.

Imports by country of consignment - countries

The share of Germany in imports by country of consignment in comparison with imports by country of origin was higher by 5.6 pp, accordingly the share of the Netherlands was higher by 2.5 pp, Belgium by 1.8 pp, Czechia by 1.0 pp and France by 0.5 pp.

In 2023 in trade turnover in goods according to the SITC nomenclature, compared to the same period of 2022, decreases were recorded in 6 sections of exports and 7 sections of imports.

In exports the largest increase concerned beverages and to bacco (by 19.8%), machinery and transport equipment (by 6.1%), food and live animals (by 5.3%), and miscellaneous manufactured articles (by 0.7%). The decrease concerned commodities and transaction not classified elsewhere in the SITC (by 34.4%), mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 18.8%), crude materials inedible, except fuels (by 15.3%), animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes (by 9.1%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 8.5%), and chemicals and related products (by 7.8%).

In imports the increase was recorded in beverages and tobacco (by 14.0%), food and live animals (by 4.8%), and machinery and transport equipment (by 4.0%). The decrease concerned commodities and transaction not classified elsewhere in the SITC (by 60.9%), animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes (by 28.3%), crude materials inedible, except fuels (by 20.2%), mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 16.7%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 15.6%), chemicals and related products (by 10.7%), and miscellaneous manufactured articles (by 6.1%).

Chart 1. Composition of exports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in 2023





Chart 2. Composition of imports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in 2023
