An increase y/y in domestic deliveries of meat

In 2020 domestic deliveries¹ of meat (including pork, beef, veal and poultry meat) amounted to PLN 4194 thousand tons and were higher by 3.7% compared to the previous year.

The deliveries of both raw meat from animals for slaughter (by 5.1%) and poultry meat (by 2.0%) increased.

The domestic market supply of selected food goods

In 2020 the deliveries of butter and dairy spreads; pasta and variety meat products from poultry were significant higher than in the previous year.

The increase in deliveries was reported also for the following foodstuffs: meat (from animals for slaughter and poultry); margarine and reduced and low fat spreads; wine and mead (of which grape wine); sugar; cheese and curd also.

In comparison with 2019, much smaller deliveries were noted for rye flour; frozen sea fish; meat and variety meat products from animals for slaughter; and vodkas, liqueurs, other spirit beverages (of which pure vodka).

In 2020 deliveries of the majority of presented foodstuffs were higher than in 2019
