

# Average paid employment, wages and salaries in the national economy in 2022 – final data


According to final data, in 2022, the average paid employment in the national economy was 11.0 million full-time equivalent employees. There were 1.5% more of them compared with the previous year.

### Average paid employment in the national economy

Compared with 2021, the average paid employment increased in the majority of sections, with the highest increase recorded in the Information and communication section (by 10.8%) and the Accommodation and catering<sup>A</sup> section (by 8.6%). Decrease in the average paid employment was recorded in three sections, with the highest decrease in the Agriculture, forestry and fishing (by 1.3%). In the Trade; repair of motor vehicles<sup>A</sup> section the average paid employment remained at the same lavel as in the previous year.

Average paid employment includes full-time employees and part-time employees converted into full-time equivalent employees

Chart 1. Average paid employment in the national economy by PKD/NACE section in 2022 – final data



#### Average monthly gross wages and salaries in the national economy

According to final data, the average monthly gross wage and salary in the national economy in Poland in 2022 was PLN 6 362.90. Compared with 2021 it increased nominally by 12.0%. The average monthly gross wage and salary by PKD/NACE section remained differentiated. In 2022, it ranged from PLN 4 133.66 in the Accommodation and catering<sup>∆</sup> section to PLN 11 098.14 in the Mining and quarrying section. These values were respectively 35.0% lower and 74.4% higher than the average monthly gross wage and salary in Poland.

In all PKD/NACE sections, increases in the average monthly nominal gross wage and salary compared with 2021 were recorded. The increases ranged from 6.0% in the Education section to 22.6% in the Mining and quarrying section.

#### Minimum gross wage and salary

In 2022, the minimum gross wage and salary increased by PLN 210.00 compared with 2021 and amounted to PLN 3 010.00. After the increase, it accounted for 47.8% of the average monthly gross wage and salary without annual awards<sup>1</sup> in 2022.

In December 2022, in national economy entities with 10 or more employed persons and budgetary units regardless of the number of employed persons, 402.1 thousand employees received wages and salaries that were equal to or lower than the minimum gross wage and salary.

In 2022, the average monthly nominal gross wage and salary increased by 12.0% compared with 2021
