

Pensioners employed in the national economy¹ in March 2023


Share of pensioners in the total number of employed persons in March 2023

At the end of March 2023, there were 783.3 thousand pensioners (old-age pensioners and other pensioners) employed in the national economy, 50.5% of whom were women.

As at 31 March 2023, the number of pensioners employed in the national economy increased by 5.0% compared with January 2023. The number of employed pensioners in terms of place of residence increased most in the Podlaskie region (by 6.4%).

Nearly 23% of all employed pensioners worked in the public sector. In terms of place of residence, the largest part of employed pensioners from the public sector was in the Warszawski stołeczny region (32.7%), and the smallest in the Świętokrzyskie region (17.1%).

Map 1. Share of pensioners in the total number of employed persons in the national economy by place of residence in 2023




On the last day of March 2023, women accounted for 55.7% of employed pensioners in the Warszawski stołeczny region

¹ Information on pensioners concerns employed persons who have informed their contribution payer that they are entitled to a retirement pension (i.e. an old-age pension) or other pension. The data do not include information on pensioners insured with the Agricultural Social Insurance Fund (KRUS).

The increase in the number of pensioners employed in the national economy compared with January 2023 occurred in all PKD/NACE sections, and the highest in the Education section (by 9.9%).

On the last day of March 2023, in 10 out of 19 PKD/NACE sections, the vast majority of employed pensioners (over 90%) were related to the private sector

Among employed pensioners, the most feminised section was Human health and social work activities (almost 80% of pensioners employed in this section are women). The most masculinised section was Mining and quarrying (nine out of ten employed persons are men).
