

## Disabled employed persons in the national economy<sup>1</sup> in June 2023


At the end of June 2023, there were 477.4 thousand disabled employed persons in the national economy, of whom 51.5% were women.

As at 30 June 2023, the number of disabled employed persons in the national economy was 477.4 thousand (an increase of 1.2% relative to January 2023). The largest increase in the number of disabled employed persons by place of residence was in the Świętokrzyskie region (an increase of 2.3%). Only in the Warmińsko-Mazurskie region was the number of disabled employed persons at the same level as in January 2023.

Of the total number of disabled employed persons, nearly 22% worked in the public sector. In terms of place of residence, the largest share of disabled employed persons connected with the public sector was in the Lubelskie region (29.1%) and the smallest in the Wielkopolskie region (17.1%).


On the last day of June 2023, women accounted for 55.0% of disabled employed persons in the Pomorskie region

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Information on disabled persons refers to employed persons who have informed their contribution payer that they have a disability certificate. The data do not include information on disabled persons insured with the Agricultural Social Insurance Fund (KRUS).

An increase in the number of disabled employed persons in the national economy relative to January 2023 occurred in the majority of PKD/NACE sections, and the highest was in the Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities section (by 4.5%). There was a decrease only in the Manufacturing section (by 0.3%).

PKD/NACE sections:

- Administrative and support service activities
- Manufacturing
- Trade; repair of motor vehicles<sup>Δ</sup>
- Human health and social work activities
- Public administration and defence; compulsory social security
- Others

Among disabled employed persons, the most feminised section was Human health and social work activities (almost 80% of disabled employed persons in this section were women). The most masculinised section was Construction (eight out of ten disabled employed persons were men).

On the last day of June 2023, in 7 out of the 19 PKD/NACE sections, among disabled employed persons, the vast majority (more than 90%) were related to the private sector
