

# Average paid employment<sup>1</sup> and average gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in September 2023

There was no y/y change in the average paid employment in the enterprise sector

In September 2023, the average paid employment in the enterprise sector was similar to that recorded in September 2022 and amounted to 6 496.1 thousand full-time equivalent employees. Compared with the previous month, the average paid employment was lower by 0.1%.

Increase y/y in the average gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector

Average gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in September 2023 compared with September 2022 increased nominally by 10.3% and amounted to PLN 7 379.88 gross. Compared with August 2023 average gross wages and salaries increased nominally by 0.1%.

# Labour market in the enterprise sector

The enterprise sector is part of the national economy, which means that data concern units conducting economic activity classified into **selected**<sup>2</sup> **kinds of activity according to NACE Rev.2, with 10 or more employed persons.** Therefore, the survey does not include, inter alia, public administration, education, human health and social work activities. Basic data on this sector are published monthly and for the national economy as a whole quarterly, e.g. in the statistical information *Paid employment, wages and salaries in the national economy*.

In September 2023, **the average paid employment** in the enterprise sector decreased by 0.1% compared with August 2023, while in August 2023 compared with July 2023 it decreased by 0.2%. Over the year (September 2023 to September 2022), the average paid employment was recorded at a similar level.


Chart 1. Average paid employment in the enterprise sector

In September 2023, the average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector slightly increased in nominal terms compared with August 2023 by 0.1%.

The highest nominal increase in the average monthly gross wage and salary compared with the previous month was recorded in the Other service activities section (by 3.0%). The highest value of the average monthly wage and salary in September 2023 occurred in the Information and communication section (PLN 12 313.32), and the lowest in the Accommodation and catering<sup>a</sup> section (PLN 5 446.36).

Over the year (September 2023 to September 2022), the average monthly gross wage and salary increased nominally by 10.3%.

In July 2023, the statutory minimum salary was raised to PLN 3 600, i.e. by 19.6% compared with 2022, when it amounted to PLN 3 010 (in 2022 an increase of 7.5% compared with 2021), which also affected changes in average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector

The average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector in the nine months of 2023 (cumulatively) compared with the same period of 2022 increased nominally by 12.0%. The increase occurred in all PKD/NACE sections, ranging from 6.9% in the Construction section to 16.1% in the Transportation and storage section. The highest average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector in the cumulative period was recorded in the Information and communication section (PLN 12 477.40), and the lowest in the Accommodation and catering<sup>\( \Delta\)</sup> section (PLN 5 308.53).

### **Methodological notes**

The enterprise sector comprises units with 10 or more employed persons, conducting economic activity within the scope of the following areas: forestry and logging; marine fishing; mining and quarrying; manufacturing; electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply; water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities; construction; wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles; transportation and storage; accommodation and food service activities; information and communication; real estate activities; legal and accounting activities; activities of head offices; management consultancy activities; architectural and engineering activities; technical testing and analysis; advertising and market research; other professional, scientific and technical activities; administrative and support service activities; arts, entertainment and recreation; repair of computers and personal and household goods; other personal service activities.

Data source is 'Report on economic activity' (DG-1). Within the scope of this survey, for the entities with 50 or more employed persons it is a census survey, while for the entities with 10 to 49 employed persons it is a sample survey<sup>3</sup>.

Labour market data from the DG-1 survey report do not include people employed under a contract of mandate and a contract to perform a specified task – the detailed scope of exclusions along with methods of calculating labour market variables can be found in the explanations of the DG-1 report<sup>4</sup>.

Due to the short time in which the units provide data as part of the survey on the DG-1 form, the presented results are preliminary. In the absence of complete records as at the date of preparation of the report, it is allowed to include estimated data, and in the event of the need to correct data reported in previous periods, changes are included only in cumulative data.

In this news release abbreviated names of NACE, Rev. 2 sections were used. Abbreviations are marked with a ' $\Delta$ ' symbol. Full names are available on the Eurostat website at: https://ec.europa.eu/eurostat/data/classifications.
