

Index numbers of sold production of industry in December 2019^{a)}




Increase in sold production of industry, as compared to December 2018 In December 2019, sold production of industry was by 3.8% higher than in December 2018, when the growth was recorded by 2.9%, whereas in comparison with November 2019, it decreased by 9.4%. In the period January-December of 2019, sold production of industry was by 4.0% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 5.8% was recorded.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in December 2019 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 2.1% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 2.9% lower as compared to November 2019.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in December 2019 amounted to 2.1% per year



In most of the main industrial groupings, in December 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase of production was recorded. The production of capital goods increased by 6.1%, non-durable consumer goods – by 4.6%, durable consumer goods – by 4.2%, intermediate goods – by 3.1%. A decrease was observed in the production of energy – by 2.5%.



According to the preliminary data, in December 2019, as compared to December 2018, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 24 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 41.5%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 10.0%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 9.9%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 8.8%, manufacture of metal products – by 7.0%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 6.3%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to December 2018, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 15.0%, manufacture of textiles – by 5.6%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 5.0%, in manufacture of basic metals – by 4.4%.
