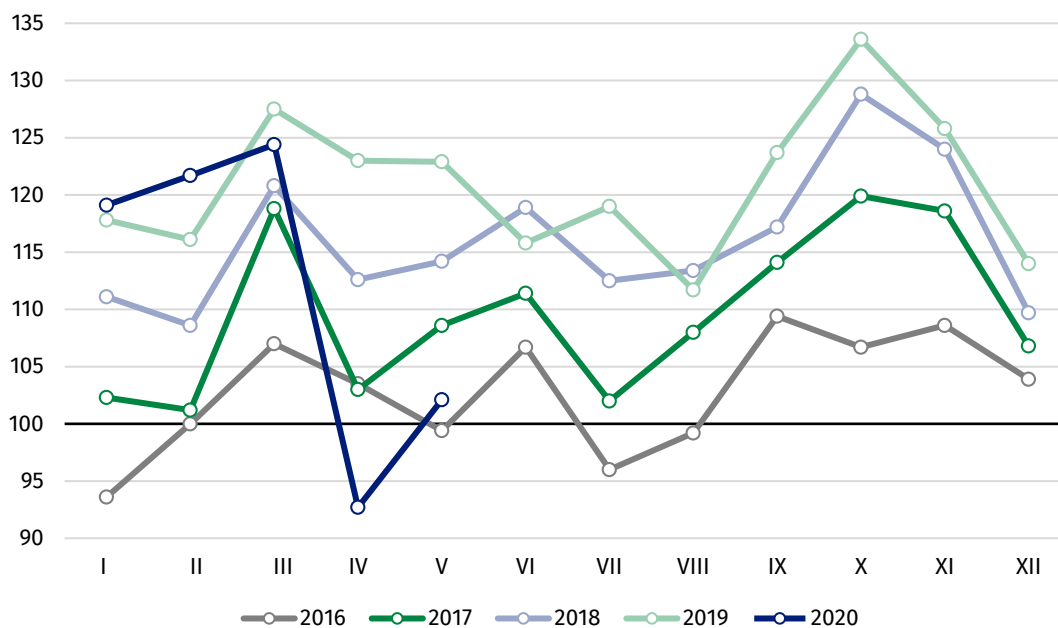
Decrease in sold production of industry as compared to May 2019

In May 2020, sold production of industry was by 17.0% lower than in May 2019, when the growth was recorded by 7.7% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with April 2020, it increased by 10.1%. In the period January-May of 2020, sold production of industry was by 7.9% lower than in the corresponding period of 2019, which saw a 7.0% increase.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in May 2020 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 15.5% than in the corresponding month of 2019 and by 12.2% higher as compared to April 2020.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in May 2020 amounted to 15.5% per year

In all main industrial groupings in May 2020, as compared to the previous year, a decrease of production was recorded. The production of capital goods lowered by 38.4%, durable consumer goods – by 13.7%, intermediate goods – by 13.5%, production of energy – by 10.0% and non-durable consumer goods – by 8.7%.

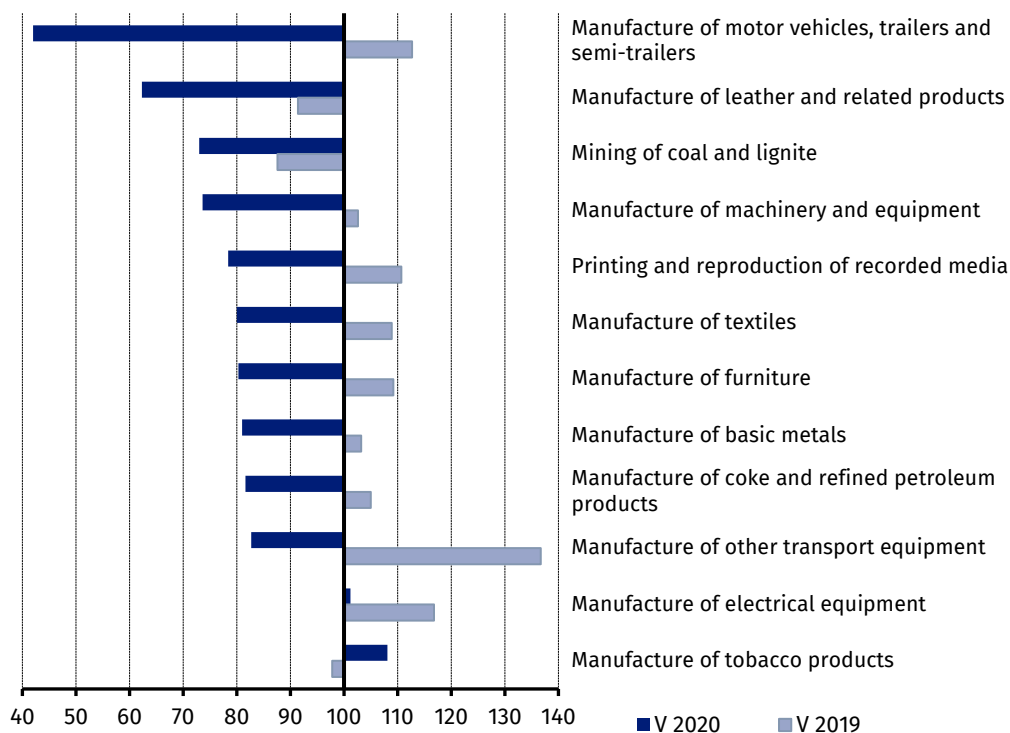

According to the preliminary data, in May 2020, as compared to May 2019, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 30 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 58.0%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 27.0%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 26.4%, manufacture of furniture – by 19.7%, manufacture of basic metals – by 19.0%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 18.4%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 17.2%, manufacture of metal products – by 16.5%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to May 2019, was recorded in 4 divisions, among others, in manufacture of tobacco products – by 8.1% and manufacture of electrical equipment – by 1.2%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw a decrease in comparison to May 2019, stood at 93.8%

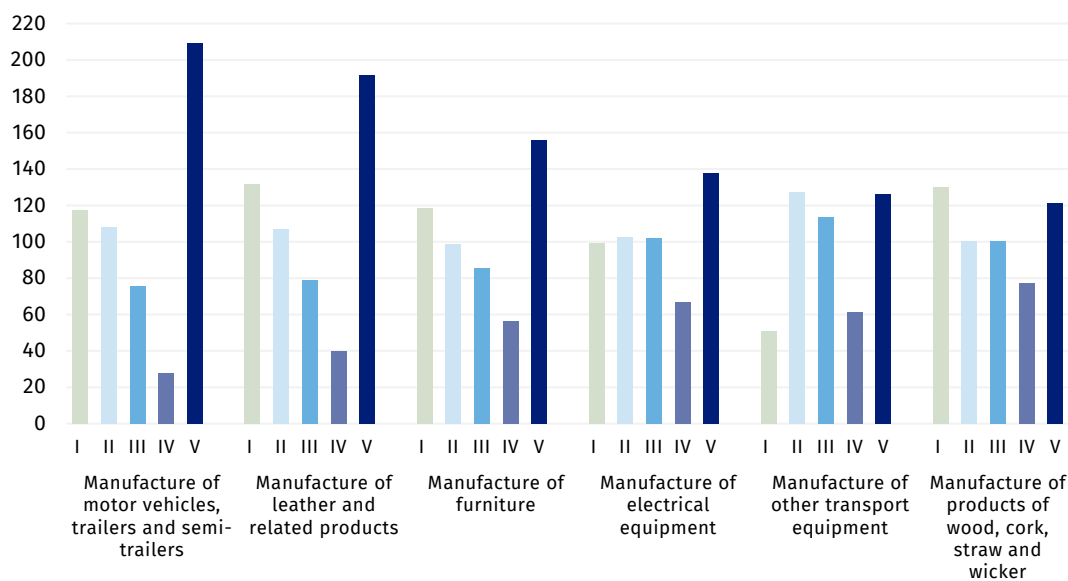
Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)



Compared to April 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in May 2020 was recorded in 25 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 109,1%, manufacture of leather and related products – by 91.4%, manufacture of furniture – by 56.0%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 37.6%, manufacture of textiles – by 28.2%, manufacture of wearing apparel – by 26.5%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 12.5%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.4%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 10.1%. In these divisions, a significant reduction in sold production was observed in April 2020 as compared to March 2020.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to April 2020, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in mining of coal and lignite – by 14.3%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 8.8% and in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 5.2%.
