# Index numbers of sold production of industry in January 2021<sup>a)</sup>

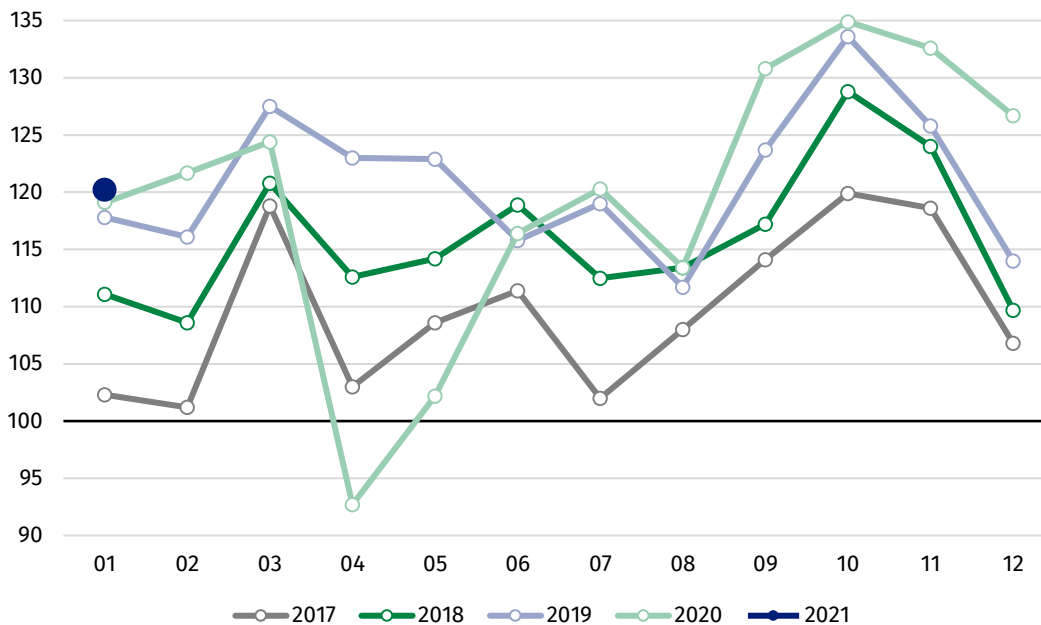
Increase in sold production of industry as compared to January 2020

In January 2021, sold production of industry was by 0.9% higher than in January 2020, when an increase was recorded by 1.1% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with December 2020 it decreased by 5.1%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in January 2021 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 5.7% than in the corresponding month of 2020 and by 1.7% higher as compared to December 2020.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in January 2021 amounted 5.7% per year

**Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2015=100)**



In January 2021, as compared to the previous year, a decrease of production was recorded in three main industrial groupings. The production of non-durable consumer goods decreased by 5.2%, energy – by 4.9% and capital goods – by 1.3%. An increase was observed in the production of intermediate goods – by 4.4% and durable consumer goods – by 3.7%.

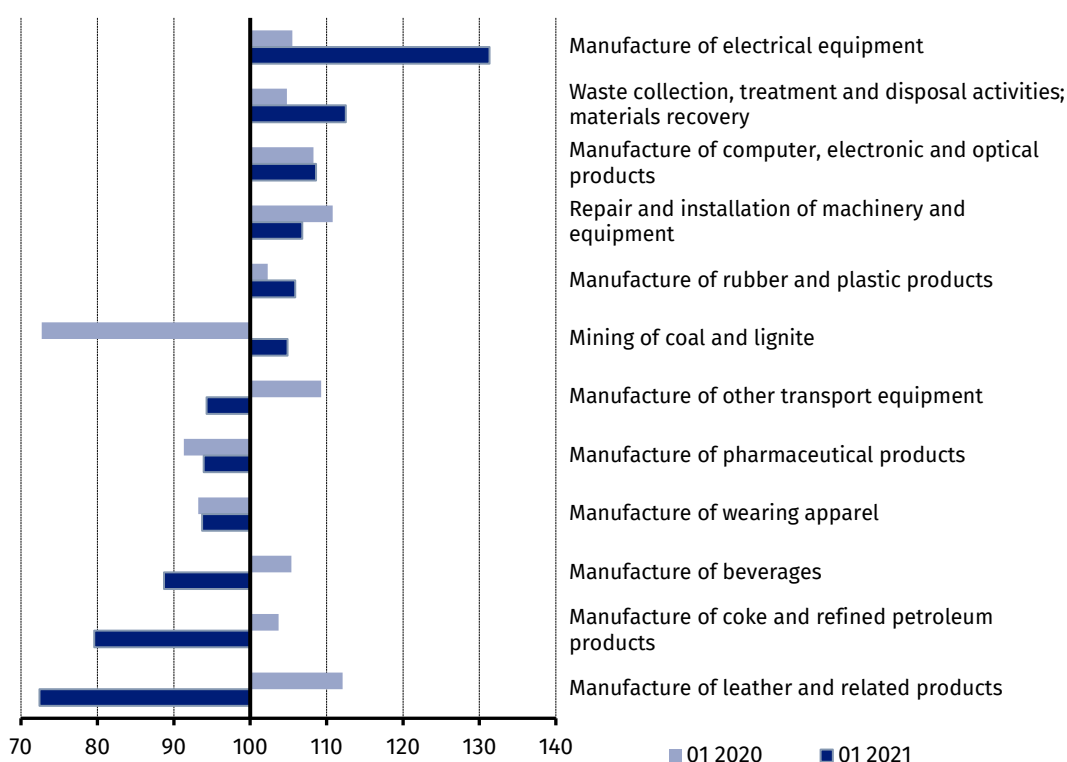

According to the preliminary data in January 2021, as compared to January 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 15 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 31.3%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 12.5%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 8.6%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 5.9%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 4.9%, in manufacture of basic metals – by 4.6%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 4.3%.

Share of production value of industry divisions which saw an increase in comparison to January 2020 stood at 52.3%

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to January 2020, was recorded in 19 divisions, among others, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 20.4%, manufacture of beverages – by 11.3%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 6.1%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 5.7%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 3.5%.

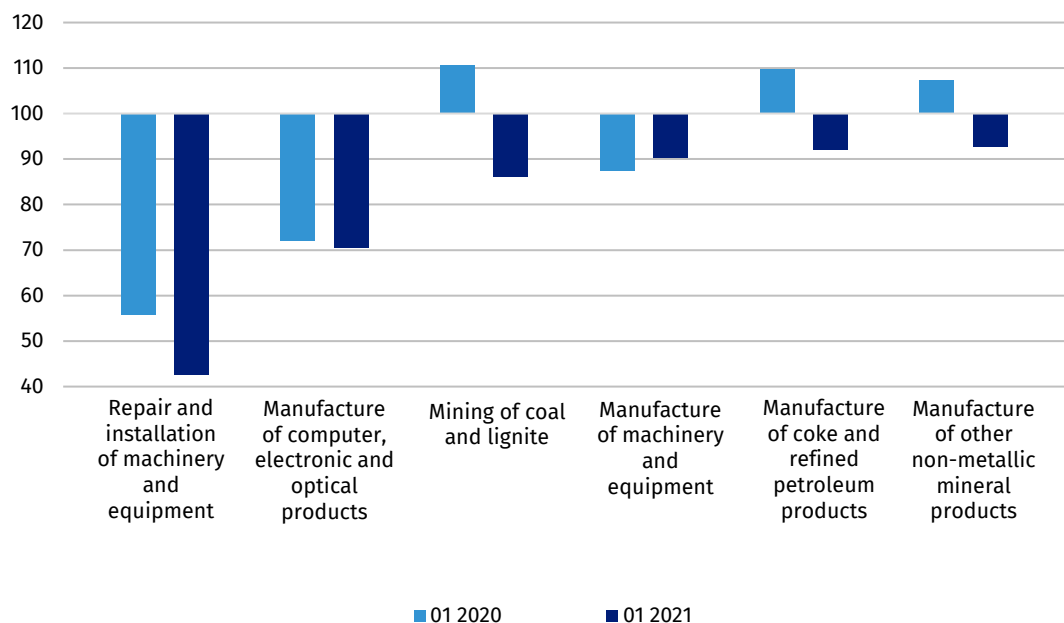
**Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)**



As compared to December 2020, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in January 2021 was recorded in 26 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 44.8%, manufacture of beverages – by 30.1%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 29.5%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 13.9%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 12.7%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 9.7%, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 8.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 7.3%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to December 2020, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 45.0%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 11.3%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 9.9%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 9.0%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 8.4%.
