In August 2023, sold production of industry was by 2.0% lower than in August 2022, when an increase was recorded by 10.9% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with July 2023, it increased by 1.0%. In the period January-August of 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.9% lower than in the corresponding period of 2022, which saw an increase by 12.9% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in August 2023 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 1.8% than in the corresponding month of 2022 and by 0.6% higher as compared to July 2023.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in August 2023 amounted to 1.8% per year




Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2015=100)

In August 2023, among the main industrial groupings there was a decrease per year in the production of intermediate goods – by 7.8%, durable consumer goods – by 6.4%, energy – by 4.4% and slight in non-durable consumer goods – by 0.9%. An increase was observed in the production of capital goods – by 10.5%.



According to the preliminary data, in August 2023 as compared to August 2022, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 23 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in mining of coal and lignite - by 19.9%, in manufacture of basic metals - by 17.9%, manufacture of paper and paper products - by 12.3%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products - by 12.2%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker by 11.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products - by 8.5%, manufacture of electrical equipment - by 7.3%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products - by 7.0%. An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to August 2022, was recorded in 11 divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 22.0%, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 15.3%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers - by 14.0%, manufacture of machinery and equipment - by 9.9%.

08 2022 08 2023 As compared to July 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in August 2023 was recorded in 21 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of furniture – by 24.1%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 9.3%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 6.5%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 5.4%, in manufacture of food products – by 4.1%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 3.9%, manufacture of metal products – by 3.7%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2023, was recorded in 13 divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 13.7%, manufacture of basic metals – by 2.6%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 2.2%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 1.8%.




Chart 3. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous month =100)
