Increase in sold production of industry as compared to October 2022


In October 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.6% higher than in October 2022, when an increase was recorded by 6.6% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with September 2023, it increased by 4.1%. In the period January-October of 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.5% lower than in the corresponding period of 2022, which saw an increase by 11.6% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in October 2023 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 0.8% than in the corresponding month of 2022 and by 0.1% lower as compared to September 2023.

# Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2015=100)



In October 2023, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of energy – by 11.0%, capital goods – by 5.9% and non-durable consumer goods – by 2.5%. A decrease was observed in the production of intermediate goods – by 3.9% and durable consumer goods – by 2.2%.



According to the preliminary data, in October 2023 as compared to October 2022, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 21 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 19.6%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 17.2%, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 7.5%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 4.3%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 4.1%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 4.0%, manufacture of metal products – by 3.2%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to October 2022, was recorded in 13 divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 16.6%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 13.0%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 10.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products and manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 5.0% each, manufacture of basic metals – by 4.0%.



As compared to September 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in October 2023 was recorded in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 30.3%, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 8.6%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 7.3%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 6.4%, in manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 4.3%, manufacture of food products – by 4.2%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to September 2023, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others, in manufacture of beverages – by 11.9%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 2.1%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 1.5%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 1.2%.
