


Decrease in sold production of industry as compared to November 2022

In November 2023, sold production of industry was by 0.7% lower than in November 2022, when an increase was recorded by 4.5% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with October 2023, it increased by 0.2%. In the period January-November of 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.4% lower than in the corresponding period of 2022, which saw an increase by 10.9% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in November 2023 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 3.3% than in the corresponding month of 2022 and by 0.3% lower as compared to October 2023.

In November 2023, among the main industrial groupings there was a decrease per year in the production of durable consumer goods – by 7.7% and intermediate goods – by 7.6%. An increase was observed in the production of capital goods – by 7.0%, energy – by 4.5% and non-durable consumer goods – by 1.8%.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in November 2023 amounted to 3.3% per year



According to the preliminary data, in November 2023 as compared to November 2022, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 17 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 26.5%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products - by 13.0%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products - by 11.6%, in mining of coal and lignite - by 8.5%, in manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker - by 7.7%, manufacture of machinery and equipment - by 6.6%, manufacture of paper and paper products - by 5.4%, manufacture of basic metals - by 5.0%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to November 2022, was recorded in 17 divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment - by 31.9%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment - by 20.5%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 11.9%, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi--trailers - by 10.2%.



As compared to October 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in November 2023 was recorded in 16 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 25.7%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 15.3%, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 12.2%, manufacture of beverages – by 6.3%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 3.9%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to October 2023, was recorded in 18 divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 10.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 10.0%, in manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 9.8%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 5.9%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 5.1%, manufacture of basic metals – by 4.9%
