


Index numbers of sold production of industry in February 2024^{a)}



In February 2024, sold production of industry was by 3.3% higher than in February 2023, when a decrease was recorded by 1.6% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with January 2024, it increased by 0.7%. In the period January-February of 2024, sold production of industry was by 2.8% higher than in the corresponding period of 2023.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in February 2024 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 1.1% than in the corresponding month of 2023 and by 0.1% lower as compared to January 2024.

In February 2024, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of capital goods – by 11.5%, non-durable consumer goods – by 3.8% and intermediate goods – by 1.0%. A decrease was observed in the production of energy – by 1.8% and slight in durable consumer goods – by 0.1%.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in February 2024 amounted to 1.1% per year



According to the preliminary data, in February 2024 as compared to February 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 24 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 48.5%, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 17.8%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers – by 13.9%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 10.3%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 10.1%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 6.9%, manufacture of food products – by 5.5%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to February 2023, was recorded in 10 divisions, among others in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 23.9%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 18.5%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 4.3%.

Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)




Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to February 2023, stood at 73.4%

As compared to January 2024, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in February 2024 was recorded in 24 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 40.8%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 15.4%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 14.5%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 11.8%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 3.9%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 3.4%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to January 2024, was recorded in 10 divisions, among others in mining of coal and lignite – by 14.4%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 12.9%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 5.9%, manufacture of food products – by 2.1%.
