

# Index numbers of sold production of industry in March 2024<sup>a)</sup>

Decrease in sold production of industry as compared to March 2023

6.0%

In March 2024, sold production of industry was by 6.0% lower than in March 2023, when a decrease was recorded by 3.7% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with February 2024, it increased by 3.6%. In the period January-March of 2024, sold production of industry was by 0.7% lower than in the corresponding period of 2023, which saw a decrease by 1.1% as compared to the corresponding period of 2022.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in March 2024 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 3.9% than in the corresponding month of 2023 and by 5.5% lower as compared to February 2024.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in March 2024 amounted to 3.9% per year




Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2021=100)

In March 2024, in all main industrial groupings there was a decrease per year, in the production of intermediate goods – by 8.9%, durable consumer goods – by 7.1%, capital goods – by 6.3%, non-durable consumer goods – by 3.6% and the production of energy – by 2.4%.





According to the preliminary data, in March 2024 as compared to March 2023, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 29.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 25.9%, in manufacture of beverages – by 13.8%, manufacture of basic metals – by 12.5%, manufacture of metal products – by 10.3%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 9.6%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 9.3%, manufacture of furniture – by 8.1%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to March 2023, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 7.5%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 4.5%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 2.1%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw a decrease in comparison to March 2023, stood at 83.5% As compared to February 2024, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) in March 2024 was recorded in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of beverages – by 28.0%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 21.2%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 10.6%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 9.5%, manufacture of food products – by 8.7%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 7.3%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 6.8%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to February 2024, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 19.8%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 3.7%, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi--trailers – by 1.8%, manufacture of furniture – by 1.3%.




Chart 3. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous month =100)
