Increase in sold production of industry as compared to July 2023

In July 2024, sold production of industry was by 4.9% higher than in July 2023, when a decrease was recorded by 2.7% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with June 2024, it decreased by 3.3%. In the period January-July of 2024, sold production of industry was by 0.6% higher than in the corresponding period of 2023, which saw a decrease by 2.3% as compared to the corresponding period of 2022.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in July 2024 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 2.2% than in the corresponding month of 2023 and by 0,2% lower as compared to June 2024.

In July 2024, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of durable consumer goods – by 12.7%, energy – by 7.4%, non-durable consumer goods – by 7.0% and intermediate goods – by 5.1%. A decrease was observed in the production of capital goods – by 1.7%.



According to the preliminary data, in July 2024 as compared to July 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 21.0%, manufacture of furniture – by 14.5%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 13.9%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 10.9%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 10.8%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 10.0%, manufacture of food products – by 9.4%, manufacture of basic metals – by 8.6%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2023, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 18.7%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 9.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 5.2%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 3.8%.

Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)




Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to July 2023, stood at 81.8%

As compared to June 2024, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in July 2024 was recorded in 19 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 18.2%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 14.3%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 13.1%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 8.9%, manufacture of metal products – by 7.6%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 6.5%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to June 2024, was recorded in 15 divisions, among others in mining of coal and lignite – by 3.8%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 3.1%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 2.3%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 2.0%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 1.9%.
