Index number of sold production of industry, as compared to July 2018

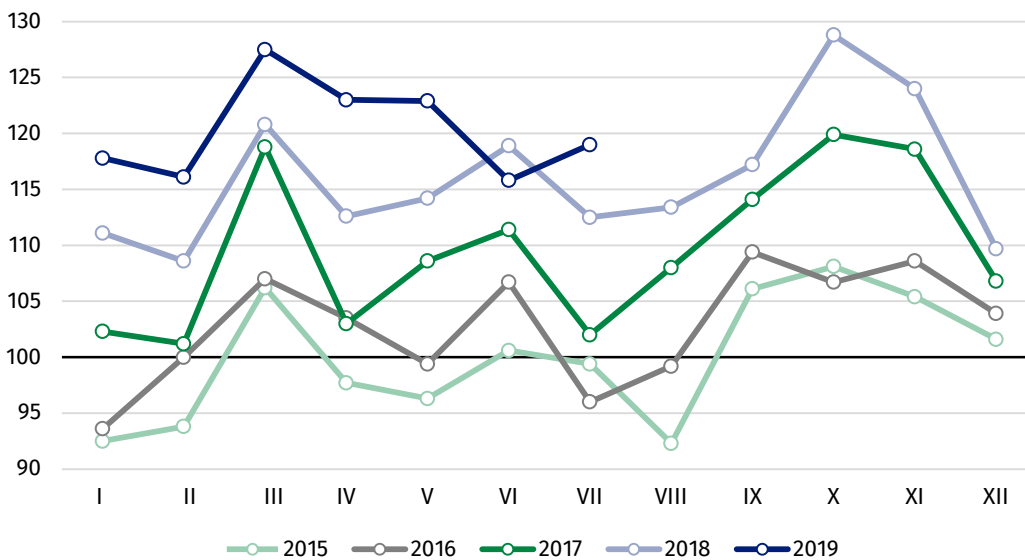
In July 2019, sold production of industry was by 5.8% higher than in July 2018, when the growth was recorded by 10.3%, whereas in comparison with June 2019, it increased by 2.8%. In the period January-July of 2019, sold production of industry was by 5.1% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 6.7% was recorded.

Increase in sold production of industry in July 2019 amounted to 5.8%, against an increase of 10.3% in the previous year

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in July 2019 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.7% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 0.9% higher as compared to June 2019.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in July 2019 amounted to 3.7% per year

Chart 1. Sold production of industry (average monthly level in 2015=100)



In all of the main industrial groupings, in July 2019, as compared to the previous year, an increase of production was recorded. The production of capital goods increased by 10.0%, non-durable consumer goods – by 5.7%, durable consumer goods – by 5.0%, intermediate goods – by 4.2% and energy – by 1.4%.

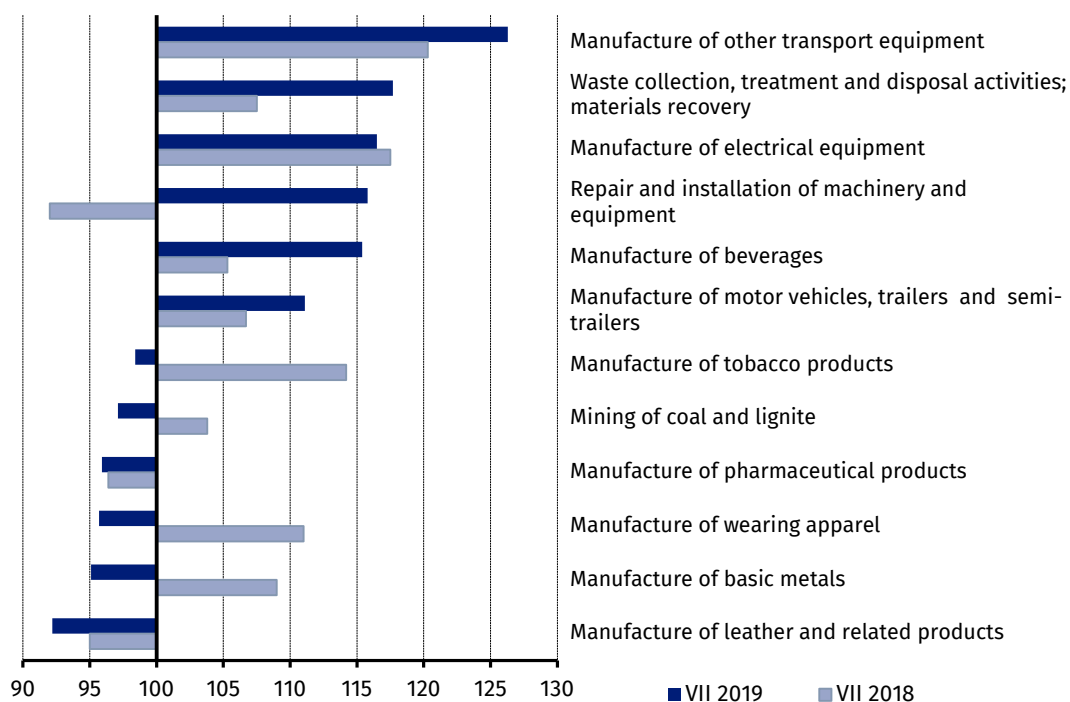

According to the preliminary data, in July 2019, as compared to July 2018, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 26.3%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 16.5%, manufacture of beverages – by 15.4%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 11.1%, manufacture of textiles – by 9.7%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 8.0%, manufacture of metal products – by 6.5%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2018, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others in manufacture of basic metals – by 4.9%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 4.1%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 2.9%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in their index numbers, stood at 85.2%
