

# Index numbers of sold production of industry in August 2019<sup>a)</sup>



In August 2019, sold production of industry was by 1.3% lower than in August 2018, when the growth was recorded by 5.0%, whereas in comparison with July 2019, it decreased by 6.0%. In the period January-August of 2019, sold production of industry was by 4.3% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 6.5% was recorded.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in August 2019 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 1.7% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 1.2% lower as compared to July 2019.


After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in August 2019 amounted to 1.7% per year

In most of the main industrial groupings, in August 2019, as compared to the previous year, a decrease of production was recorded. The production of capital goods decreased by 4.5%, energy – by 4.4% and intermediate goods – by 0.8%. A slight increase was observed in the production of durable consumer goods – by 0.6% and non-durable consumer goods – by 0.2%.



According to the preliminary data, in August 2019, as compared to August 2018, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 18 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 10.8%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 8.9%, in mining of cool and lignite – by 8.4%, in manufacture of basic metals – by 6.3%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 4.6%. An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to August 2018, was recorded in 16 divisions, among others in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 7.3%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 6.4%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 4.2%.
