Index number of construction and assembly production as compared to January of 2021

According to preliminary data construction and assembly production (in constant prices) carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in January 2022 by 20.8% higher than a year before (against a decrease of 10.1% the year before) and by 56.5% lower compared with December 2021 (a decrease of 62.9% the year before).

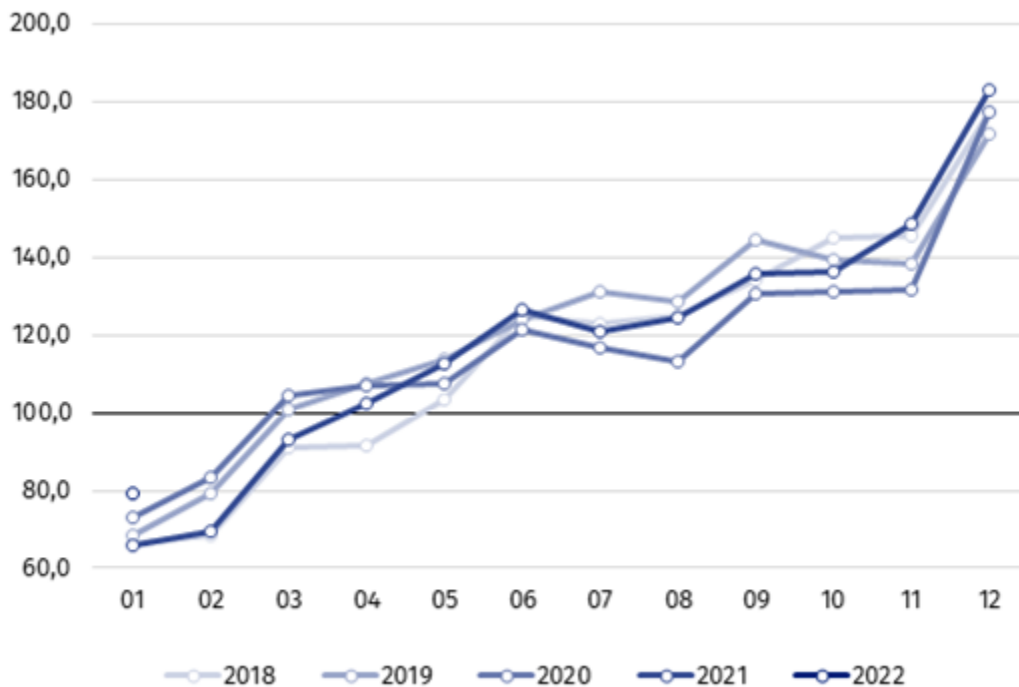
Sales of construction and assembly production in January 2022, compared to the corresponding period of 2021, increased in all division of construction, in entities dealing mainly with construction of buildings (39.0%), performing specialised construction activities (14.7%) and in entities whose basic type of activity were civil engineering works (7.6%).

Compared with December 2021, a decrease in the value of works carried out was noted in entities dealing mainly with civil engineering works by 70.8%. Decreases were recorded in performing specialised construction activities by 51.5% and in whose basic type of activity was construction of buildings by 37.3%.

¹ Reported data; comprise enterprises employing over 9 persons, whose the main type of activity is included in the section F "Construction" in accordance with the Polish Classification of Activities (PKD 2007).

Value of construction and assembly production, compared to January 2021, increased both for investment works by 21.6% and restoration works by 19.6% (against a decrease of 15.5% and 0.9% in the year before).

Index number of construction and assembly production in January 2022 (in constant prices), compared to the average monthly value of 2015, was 79.4.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 18.5% higher than in January 2021 and by 19.0% higher in comparison to December 2021.
