


Activity of centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres in 2020




As of the end of 2020, there were 4040 operating centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres. During the year entities organised 120.9 thousand events, in which took part 13.4 million participants.

Due to the announcement of the state of epidemic threat in Poland, from March 12, 2020, the possibility of conducting business activities was limited, among others, by cultural entities that had to close their facilities overnight. The introduced limitations resulted in changes in the functioning of cultural entities in terms of the implementation of cultural activities. At that time, some units did not undertake any activities related to the preparation and sharing of the cultural offer, and some tried to reach the recipient by making their offer available on the Internet. Restrictions on the activities of cultural entities in individual months had a different scope and forms, depending on the current epidemic situation in the country.

Most centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres were operating in Małopolskie Voivodship (453), and the least in Lubuskie Voivodship (72). Taking into account the type of entities, most numerous group constituted community centres (32.6% of the total number of entities), whereas the least numerous were clubs (7.6%). Most of the entities (62.0%) were located in the countryside.

The prevalent part of centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres (93.0%) belonged to the public sector. Local government units at the level of gmina played dominant role organising the activity of 90.5% of all public entities.

In 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic had a significant impact on the activities of centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres. The number of entities that limited their cultural activities for this reason was 69.0%.

Centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres organised a total of 120.9 thousand events, in which 13.4 million people took part. The largest number of events (37.8 thousand) was organized by cultural centres, and the least - clubs and community centres (7.4 thousand and 7.8 thousand events, respectively). In comparison to 2019 the number of organised events decreased by 50.4% and the number of participants – by 64.4%.

Workshops were most frequently organised (27.1% of the total number of events), whereas conferences were the least frequently organised (0.5% of the total number of events). On average 110 people took part in 1 event. Festivals and artistic reviews were the most numerous in this respect – on average 935 people attended 1 event.


In 2020, 43.9% of centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres conducted online cultural activities, which provided 32.7 thousand events and 0.6 thousand courses.

As of the end of 2020, 24.1 thousand various types of groups (clubs/sections) were operating in centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres, gathering 466.3 thousand members. In the form of groups (clubs/sections) mostly were organised art and technical classes (5.4 thousand). The largest number of participants gathered senior clubs and The Third Age Universities (93.4 thousand people).

In 2020 entities conducted a total of 4.8 thousand courses. 64.9 thousand people obtained the graduated status of the course (a decrease of 35.8% in comparison to 2019). Mostly were conducted courses related to learning to play the instruments (23.2% of the total number of courses) and foreign language courses (22.8%).

Chart 1. The structure of groups (clubs, sections) and their participants in centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres in 2020



As of the end of 2020, 14.2 thousand artistic groups were operating in centres of culture, cultural establishments, cultural centres, clubs and community centres, among which most numerous were dance groups (3.7 thousand). From the total number of 230.6 thousand artistic groups participants, 64.5% were school children and youth. Every fifth artistic groups participants was person above 60 years old.
