

Occupancy of tourist accommodation establishments in the first quarter of 2024

(concerns tourist accommodation establishments with 10 or more bed places)



In the first quarter of 2024, 7.1 million tourists were accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments, with 17.4 million overnight stays provided to them. Compared to the first quarter of 2023, the number of tourists staying in accommodation establishments increased by 0.7%, while the number of overnight stays provided to them increased by 0.3%.



Occupancy of tourist accommodation establishments in the first quarter of 2024

In the first quarter of 2024, there was an increase in the occupancy of tourist accommodation establishments in Poland compared to the same period of 2023. According to the results obtained from the tourist accommodation establishments survey, 7.1 million tourists were accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments in the first quarter of 2024, of which 5.7 million were domestic tourists and 1.4 million were foreign tourists. Compared to the first quarter of 2023, the number of total tourists increased by 0.7%, of which the number of domestic tourists decreased by 0.3%, while the number of foreign tourists increased by 5.1%.

Among foreign tourists, visitors from Europe were the most frequent users of accommodation establishments – 1.2 million. They accounted for 86.2% of all foreign tourists and their number was 5.3% more than in the first quarter of 2023. The largest number of tourists came from Germany (309.6 thousand), followed by tourists from Ukraine (184.9 thousand) and tourists from the United Kingdom (158.9 thousand). Tourists from these three countries constituted together 46.2% of the total number of foreign tourists who were accommodated in tourist establishments in Poland in the first quarter of 2024.

Compared to the same period last year, 14 of the 20 types of establishments saw an increase in the number of tourists. The largest increase in the number of tourists occurred at complexes of tourist cottages (by 155.1%). Tourists also significantly increased at camping sites (by 84.0%), holiday youth centres (by 70.0%) and tent camp sites (by 69.8%). A decrease in the number of tourists compared to the first quarter of the previous year was recorded to the greatest extent at creative arts centres (by 5.2%), followed by health establishments (by 4.4%) and hostels (by 2.3%). In the first quarter of 2024, tourists were most likely to choose to stay in hotels, where 5.2 million people stayed. Overnight statys in these establishments were provided to 71.8% of all domestic tourists and 82.8% of all foreign tourists.


In the first quarter of 2024, 4.1 million domestic tourists were accommodated in hotels

Compared with the first quarter of 2023, an increase in the number of tourists accommodated was recorded in 7 voivodships, with the largest in Zachodniopomorskie Voivodship (by 9.7%) and the largest decrease was in Lubelskie Voivodship (by 12.1%). Nearly half of tourists (48.7%) accommodated in the first quarter of 2024, stayed in three voivodships: Mazowieckie, Małopolskie and Dolnośląskie (3.4 million in total). The fewest tourists (63.5 thousand) stayed in establishments located in Opolskie Voivodship – 0.9% of the total.


Chart 2. Tourists accommodated by voivodship



In the first quarter of 2024, tourists made 17.4 million overnight stays (i.e. 0.3% more than in the corresponding quarter of 2023). Domestic tourists made 14.1 million overnight stays, and foreign tourists – 3.3 million. Compared to the first quarter of 2023, there was an 0.4% decrease in the number of overnight stays provided to domestic tourists and a 3.4% increase in overnight stays provided to foreign tourists. Tourists were most likely to choose hotels, where they made 10.3 million overnight stays i.e. 1.2% less than a year ago.


In the first quarter of 2024, 57.4 thousand fewer overnight stays were provided to tourists than in the same quarter last year

Chart 3. Overnight stays provided in tourist accommodation establishments by voivodship



The highest number of overnight stays was provided in Małopolskie Voivodship – 3.3 million (18.8% of the total), and the lowest in Opolskie Voivodship – 140.3 thousand (0.8%). The increase in the number of overnight stays was recorded in 7 voivodships. The largest increase was in Pomorskie Voivodship (by 6.8%), while the largest decrease was in Lubelskie Voivodship (by 17.2%). In the first quarter of 2024, the occupancy rate was 34.0% and was 1.7 pp lower than in the first quarter of last year. The lowest occupancy rate was recorded in January – 32.3% (down 0.7 pp). In February this year, the value of this rate was 36.6% (a decrease of 3.0 pp), while in March this year it amounted to 33.3%, compared to 34.9% a year ago.

In hotels and similar establishments, 7.0 million rooms were rented in the first quarter of this year (7.1 million in the same period of 2023), while the occupancy rate was 43.2%, 1.7 pp lower than in the first quarter of last year.
