

Structural business statistics in 2022


In 2022, the turnover of enterprises covered by the survey of structural business statistics reached 8233.4 bn PLN (25.4% more than in 2021).

According to the survey of structural business statistics, in 2022 the number of active enterprises increased by 0.4% year-on-year to 2,675.9 thousand units. This change occurred as a result of a 3.4% increase in the number of enterprises in services. Declines were recorded in other activities, including 2.9% in trade; repair of motor vehicles.

The number of persons employed increased by 1.1% in 2022 compared to the previous period and amounted to 11,511.3 thousand people, the largest increase in the number of persons employed was in other sections (by 3.5%) and services (by 2.7%).

The turnover of enterprises covered by the study of structural business statistics in 2022 amounted to 8,233.4 bn PLN (i.e. 24.2% more than in 2021). The increase in the value of turnover was recorded in all sectors: in industry (by 31.7%), in other sections (by 28.5%), in services (by 22.6%), in trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 21.8%) and in construction (by 15.7%).

Chart 2. Structural business statistics — the structure of production by kinds of activity





Structural business statistics – Poland compared to the European Union in 2021

In 2021, enterprises operating in Poland accounted for 8.6% of all enterprises in the European Union (EU), and their share in the turnover was 4.4%. The shares of the production value and the number of persons employed amounted to 4.0% and 7.3%, respectively. In particular kinds of activity, the highest shares of turnover compared to the European Union countries were recorded in construction and they amounted to 5.5%, while the share value of output was highest in industry and construction (and amounted to 4.5% each). Also in terms of the number of enterprises the largest share were recorded in construction and amounted to 11,2%. Regarding the persons employed largest share were recorded in industry and amounted to 10.1%.

Chart 4. Share of Value of output of enterprises operating in Poland compared to the EU in 2021



Data presented in this news release was prepared in accordance with the guidelines and definitions of variables (i.e. number of enterprises, number of employees, turnover, production value) contained in the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197 of 30 July 2020 laying down technical specifications and arrangements pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council on European business statistics repealing 10 legal acts in the field of business statistics (link).

Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 November 2019 on European business statistics, repealing 10 legal acts in the field of business statistics (Text with EEA relevance) (link) on the basis of which the data were prepared, extended the scope of collected data for structural statistics to include sections PKD P (Education), Q (Human health and social work activities), R (Arts, entertainment and recreation), K (Financial and insurance activities) and division 96 (Other service activities).

The data refer to the statistical unit "enterprise", which is the smallest combination of related legal units, i.e. an organizational unit producing goods and services that benefits from a certain degree of decision-making autonomy in particular as regards the allocation of its current resources. An enterprise may carry out one or more activities at one or more locations in particular, the enterprise may consist of a single legal unit. The definition of the statistical unit "enterprise" is included in Council Regulation (EEC) No 696/93 of March 15, 1993 on the statistical units for the observation and analysis of the production system in the Community (link).

The values of the variables "turnover" and "production" were subject to the consolidation process, i.e. they were decreased by the value of internal transactions between the legal units making up the statistical unit "enterprise".

The following kinds of activity have been distinguished in the news release (in accordance with the Polish Classification of Activities PKD):

- "Industry" which covers PKD sections from B (Mining and quarrying) to E (Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities);
- "Construction" section F (Construction);
- "Trade; repair of motor vehicles" section G (Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles);
- "Services", which include PKD sections from H (Transportation and storage) to J (Information and communication) and from L (Real estate activities) to N (Administrative and support services activities), as well as division 95 of section S (Repair and maintenance of computers and personal and household goods).
- "Other", which include PKD sections from P (Education) to R (Arts, entertainment and recreation) and K (Financial and insurance activities), as well as division 96 of section S (Other personal service activities) from the data presented in this news released cover more PKD sections.

The sources of data for this study was information obtained within Statistics Poland surveys on the following reports: SP – annual business survey, SP-3 – report on business activity of enterprises, F-01/I-01 – quarterly report on revenues, costs and financial result and on outlays on fixed assets, DG-1 – report on economic activity, Z-06 – report on working wages and working time, GP – statistical report for enterprise groups. In the process of data preparation, data from the tax system of the Ministry of Finance and data on persons employed from the information system of the Social Insurance Institution was also used.
